### ORDER

Institute for Education & Technical Science, III N/6/1, Ambedkar Road, Chaudhary Mohr, Ghaziabad, Uttar Pradesh applied to Northern Regional Committee, National Council for Teacher Education for seeking recognition of the B.Ed. course from the academic session 2002-2003 vide letter No. Nil dated 29.12.2001 and received on 31.12.2001.

2. The application of the institution was considered in the 43<sup>rd</sup> Meeting of NRC, whereby it was decided that the incomplete applications be rejected. The application of the Institute for Education & Technical Science, III N/6/1, Ambedkar Road, Chaudhary Mohr, Ghaziabad, Uttar Pradesh was rejected on account of following deficiency communicated vide letter from NRC No. NRC/NCTE.F-3/UP-694/2002/5248 dated 26.03.2002/ 04.04.2002.

3. "The land documents are not in favour of the institute/ society".

4. The institution preferred an Appeal in the Appellate authority of NCTE Hqrs. New Delhi. On consideration of the case the NCTE decided that the appeal:

"And Whereas the Council noted that in the application form itself, it is mentioned that registered documents as proof of ownership of land has to be attached. Further, the Council observed that according to the lease deed, the lease of 30 years can be extended up to 99 years also. However, the lease deed was registered only on the 15<sup>th</sup> April, 2002 i.e. after the last date of 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2001 for receipt of applications for the academic session 2002-2003. It is, therefore, evident that the application complete in all respect including the registered lease deed for land was not submitted before the last date prescribed for receipt of applications for the academic year 2002-2003 i.e. 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2001."

5. The institution filed a CWP No 4865 of 2003 in the High Court of Delhi. As per the order of Hon'ble High Court Delhi, dated 05.08.2002 the institution was communicated the following five deficiencies vide letter from NRC No. NRC/NCTE.F-3/UP-694/2002/8774 dated 27.11.2002.
