

ORDER

J.S. College of Education, Near Balaji Mandir, Agra Road, Shikohabad, Distt.- Firozabad (U.P.) had applied to Northern Regional Committee, National Council for Teacher Education for seeking recognition of the BTC course from the academic session 2004-2005 vide letter dated 27.01.2004 and received in NRC office dated 30.01.2004.

2. The institution was inspected on 9.7.2004 by an expert committee constituted by this office. The inspection report of the expert committee, original file of the institution, copy of the NCTE Act, 1993, Copy of the Norms and Standards and other relating documents were placed before the NRC in its 80th meeting held on 26-27 July 2004.

3. After careful perusal of the file, inspection Report and other related documents, the committee decided that the institution, in light of the provisions contained under section 15(3)(b) of NCTE Act, 1993, be given an opportunity for making the written representation within one month from the date of issue of the letter of the following deficiencies noted in the case.

- (a) Details of classrooms exclusively for BTC course.
- (b) Additional space for Science lab has not been created and equipment and consumables not procured.
- (c) Instruments for simple experiments related to educational psychology not available.
- (d) Existing psychology lab facilities are not sufficient for requirement of additional intake/new course.
- (e) Additional space has not been created and tests not procured for psychology lab.
- (f) Additional equipments and learning software has not been procured for E. T. Lab.
- (g) The number of books existing for B.Ed. Programme is 3050 only. Only 300 books have been added for BTC programme is not sufficient for running the teacher training programme effectively.
- (h) The institution needs more time to consolidate the existing programme and still more time to improve the preparedness in respect of proposed programme.

4. As per the decision of NRC, a letter No. F. NRC/NCTE/F-3/ U.P. -1492 /2003/5463 dated 06.08.2004 was issued by Northern Regional Committee, National Council for Teacher Education to the institution communicating deficiencies and giving an opportunity to make written representation within one month of date of issue of letter before refusing recognition of the proposed course on account of deficiencies noted above.
