ORDER

21 DEC 2005

WHEREAS, the Institution, namely, DAV College, Kharkhowada, Meerut (UP), vide its covering letter of its Managing Society letter dated 31st December, 2005 has made application under Section 15 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 to the Northern Regional Committee (NRC), Jaipur seeking permission to start new course of Elementary Teacher Education, also known as BTC, of two years duration from the academic session 2004-2005.

2. AND WHEREAS, the NRC constituted a team of experts to carry out inspection of the institution for verification that the institution fulfills the Norms and Standards laid down for the above teacher education course. The team of experts visited the institution on 12th December 2004 for inspection but the authorities of the institution expressed regret for the inspection seeking one month time for preparation. The Chairman of the institution also handed over a letter to the visiting inspection team, wherein it was also stated that they shall be intimating very soon after preparation for inspection. However, no intimation in this connection from the institution was received by the NRC.

3. AND WHEREAS, the NRC in its 87th meeting, after consideration of the entire matter decided to issue a notice to the institution seeking its readiness for inspection to be received latest by 25th February, 2005 and also giving an opportunity to the institution to make representation within this period. Pursuant thereof, the institution was intimated accordingly by the NRC office communication dated 11th February, 2005.

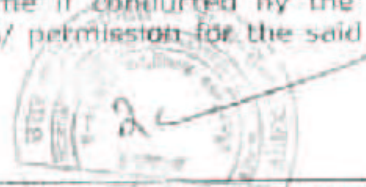
4. AND WHEREAS, when nothing was heard from the institution, the NRC in its 94th meeting held on 21st -23rd July, 2005 decided to give last opportunity by issuing a reminder to the institution to submit reply within 15 days. This decision was intimated to the institution by NRC vide its communication/letter dated 09th August, 2005.

5. AND WHEREAS, when nothing was heard from the institution, the NRC in its 98th meeting held on 24th - 25th November, 2005 decided to refuse permission of BTC course to the institution.

6. AND THEREFORE, in terms of the above decision of the NRC, the application of the institution seeking permission for the BTC programme is hereby refused under section 15 (3) (b) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

7. Consequently, the above institution shall not admit any student in BTC programme and the examining body shall not hold examination, whether provisional or otherwise for the BTC programme if conducted by the institution unless the said institution is granted recognition/ permission for the said course by the NRC/NCTE.

8. In accordance with section 17 (4) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the qualification in teacher education, namely BTC programme, obtained pursuant to such course or training in the above institution shall not be treated as valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any School, College or other educational body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.

9. Further, if the institution is not satisfied by this order, it can prefer an appeal before National Council for Teacher Education, Hans Bhawan, Wing-II, 1, Bahadur Shah Zafar Marg, Near ITO, New Delhi-110002 against this order under Section 18 of NCTE Act, 1993, within 60 days of the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for appeal are enclosed herewith.
