## ORDER

In pursuance of complaint received from the Registrar, C.C.S. University, Meerut, U.P. inspection of the institution was conducted Under Section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 and report of the inspection team was placed before the NRC in its 85<sup>th</sup> meeting, wherein the Committee took a serious note of the deficiencies existing vis-à-vis NCTE norms and decided to issue a show cause notice under section 17 of NCTE Act communicating the following deficiencies and thereby asking why the recognition be not withdrawn and to seek reply from the institution within 30 days, as an opportunity of making representation against the proposed action,

- Original No Objection Certificate has not been shown to the inspection team.
- Selection of the faculty has not been done by duly constituted team.
- Payment to the teaching staff is made by cash.
- Excess of the admissions have been made beyond the approved intake.
- Provision of separate building for teacher education course has not been made.

2. In response to the show cause notice the institution submitted a written representation vide its letter dated 04.12.2004. On careful perusal of the original file of the institution, Original VTR, written representation of the institution and other related documents, Act of NCTE 1993, Regulations and guidelines of NCTE published from time to time laid on the table of the Committee, the Regional Committee decided to withdraw recognition from the end of the current academic session i.e. 2004-2005 on account of following deficiencies observed in B.Ed. course.

- Original NOC has not been shown to the inspection team.
- Selection of the faculty has not been done by duly constituted selection team.
- Payment to the teaching staff is made by cash.
- Excess of the admissions have been made beyond the approved intake.
- Provision of separate building for teacher education course has not been made.

3. AND THEREFORE, the recognition of Mewar Institute of Management, Sector 4-C, Vasundhara, Ghaziabad, U.P. for B.Ed. course stands withdrawn from the end of the current academic session i.e. 2004-2005.

4. As a result of this order, Mewar Institute of Management, Sector 4C, Vasundhara, Ghaziabad, UP and other concerned bodies shall discontinue B.Ed. course immediately after the end of current academic session i.e. 2004-2005 and the concerned University or examining body shall cancel affiliation of the institution in accordance with this order with effect from the end of the current academic session 2004-2005 as provided under sub-section (3) of section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993.

5. The qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to that course of training in the said institution after the academic session 2004-2005 shall not be treated as valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, college or other educational body aided by the Central Government or any State Government as per sub-section (4) of section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993.
6. Further, if the institution is not satisfied by this order, it can prefer an appeal before NCTE, Headquarters against this order Under Section 18 of NCTE Act, 1993 within 60 days of the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for appeal are enclosed.
