ORDER


WHEREAS, Mewar Institute of Management, Sector 4-C, Vasundhara, Ghaziabad, U.P. was granted recognition to conduct B.Ed. course with an annual intake of 100 (One Hundred) seats with effect from the session 2002-2003 vide this office order No. F.NRC/NCTE/F-3/UP-611/2002/7601-7608 dated 29.09.2002.

2. AND WHEREAS, NRC in its 87th meeting, in proceedings initiated under Section 17 of NCTE Act, 1993, decided to withdraw the above order granting recognition to the institution for B.Ed. course. Pursuant to it, a formal order F. NRC/NCTE/F-3/UP-611/2005/13583 dated 18.02.2005 was issued by the office of NRC.

3. AND WHEREAS, since National Council for Teacher Education vide its order F.No. 89-64/2005-appeal dated 09.06.2005, in an appeal preferred before it, has reversed the above order of NRC.

4. AND THEREFORE, in pursuance of the order of NCTE, the NRC withdraws its order-dated 18.02.2005 and the order issued by this office dated 29.9.2002 granting recognition to the institution for B.Ed. course is restored to continue and remain in force till further orders.
