**ORDER**

WHEREAS, the institution, namely, Modern College of Professional Studies, 431, Anand Industrial Area, Mohan Nagar, Ghaziabad, Uttar Pradesh vide covering letter dated January 28, 2004 has made application seeking permission to start new teacher training programme of Nursery Teacher Training from the academic session 2004-2005. However, the said application was carried forward vide communication/letter of NRC No. F. NRC/NCTE/F-3/UP-1548/2004/1056 dated 26/27.04.2004 for the subsequent academic year as it was found incomplete i.e. without all the essential documents.

2. AND WHEREAS, the Inspection of the Institution was made on October 23, 2004 by a team of experts and the following deficiencies were noted:-

- (i) The number of books existing for B. Ed. programme is 3251. Only 40 books have been added for the NTT programme, which is not sufficient for running teacher training programme efficiently.
- (ii) Facilities in the Education Technology Lab are not adequately provided viz access to Internet not provided, additional equipments and learning software not procured.

3. AND WHEREAS, the NRC in its 85<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 04<sup>th</sup> and 05<sup>th</sup> November, 2004, after considering the entire matter including the deficiencies pointed out, decided to give reasonable opportunity to the institution to make written representation before refusing the above application. And pursuant thereof, the NRC vide its communication/letter No. F. NRC/NCTE/F-3/UP-1484/2004/10590 dated November 10, 2004 intimating the institution of the above deficiencies gave opportunity to make written representation within one month and to submit documentary proof duly certified by the competent authority with regard to each deficiency alongwith an affidavit.

However, instead of removing the deficiencies, the institution vide its letter dated 17.11.2004 intimated the NRC that compliance will be done in stipulated time.

4. AND WHEREAS, the deficiencies were not removed, the NRC in its 94<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup> July, 2005 decided to give a last opportunity by issuing reminder to the institution to submit its reply within 15 days. In pursuance thereof, letter No. F. NRC/NCTE/F-3/UP-1484/2004/7992 dated 09<sup>th</sup> August, 2005 was sent to the Manager/Secretary of the institution, which was replied by the institution vide letter dated 22.08.2005.

5. AND WHEREAS, the institution did not submit compliance report about removal of deficiencies, the matter was again considered by the NRC in its 96<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> September, 2005, wherein it was decided to refuse the application.

6. AND THEREFORE, in terms of above decision of NRC, the application of the institution seeking permission for the Nursery Teacher Training programme is refused under section 15 (3) (b) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

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7. Consequently, the institution shall not admit any student in Nursery Teacher Training programme and the examining body shall not hold examination, whether provisional or otherwise for the said training programme if conducted by the said institution unless it is granted permission for the same by the NRC/NCTE.

8. In accordance with section 17 (4) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the qualification in teacher education, namely Nursery Teacher Training, obtained pursuant to such course or training in the above institution shall not be treated as valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any School, College or other educational body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.

9. Further, if the institution is not satisfied by this order, it can prefer an appeal before National Council for Teacher Education, Hans Bhawan, Wing-II, 1, Bahadur Shah Zafar Marg, Near ITO, New Delhi 110002 against this order under Section 18 of NCTE Act, 1993, within 60 days of the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for appeal are enclosed herewith.
