

ORDER

The 06 (six) institutions mentioned in para 2 below submitted applications to the Northern Regional Committee of National Council for Teacher Education for grant of recognition to M.Ed. course in terms of 15(1) of NCTE Act, 1993, among others.

2. The NRC at its 109th meeting (second sitting) and 110th meeting held on 10th November, 2006 and 11th - 12th November, 2006 at NCTE Hqrs. New Delhi, considered applications of the institutions included in the Agenda for the meeting and after careful examination of relevant documents, Visiting Team Reports, Video Recording, Original File etc. found the institutions mentioned in para 2 below fit for grant of recognition of the courses and intake mentioned against their names subject to the condition of appointment of qualified staff through duly constituted selection committee as per the norms of NCTE/State Govt./Affiliating University/Body given effect before the commencement of the course etc..

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3. The institutions shall ensure the fulfillment of the following:-
- (a) The institutions shall maintain the teaching staff strength of 1+3 for the proposed M.Ed. Course.
 - (b) The institutions shall adhere to all the other regulations and guidelines as framed by NCTE from time to time.
 - (c) The institutions shall within one month of the receipt of the Recognition order, convert the Endowment Fund account into a Joint Account in the form of FDR for a period of not less than 60 months (Five Years) in a Nationalized Bank only to be operated along with an authorized official of the Regional Committee.
 - (d) That the Reserve Fund for an amount of Rs. Three Lakhs be maintained in the form of FDR in favour of the managements / institutions.
 - (e) Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC and State Government etc.
 - (f) The institutions shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating University / State Directorate of Education about the appointment of faculty members and the Statement of Annual Accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
 - (g) The institutions shall regularly update their website.
 - (h) The institutions intending to run the teacher training programme approved above in a rented premises are required to shift to their permanent building. They are required to submit report in compliance of the requirement of NCTE Regulations on the subject.
4. The order of recognition for every institution shall follow separately.
5. If any of the institutions contravene any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and / or order made or issued there under, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993. The NCTE Hqs. may also cause inspections under Section 13 of NCTE Act, 1993.
