WHEREAS in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 Smt. Amrit Kunwar Mahavidyalaya, VPO- Atara (Fifty only) students on 27.06.2003,

2. AND WHEREAS on scrutiny/perusal of the application submitted by the institution, the documents furnished therewith, the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of report and recommendation of the State Government, the Committee was satisfied that the institution/satisfy Standards for the Secondary Physical Teacher Education Programming such as instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, library, accommodation, financial resources, laboratory etc. for running the programme and has selected/appointed duly qualified teaching staff as per NCTE norms.

3. AND WHEREAS in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Northern Regional Committee granted recognisability/permission to Smt. Amrit Kunwar Mahavidyalaya, VPO- Atara (Fifty Only) students from the academic session 2009-2010 under clause 7(1) of NCTE Regulation, 2007 notified on 10.12.2007.

4. Since the recognition was granted by NRC from the session 2009-2010, the institution was aggrieved with the order and filed an appeal in the NCTE HQs. The appellant authority considered the appeal of the institution and noted that the appellant institution was granted conditional recognition by NRC on 24.07.2006 for the commencement of the session 2006-07 and permanent affiliation was extended by the State Govt. from 2006 and unconditional recognition was issued by NRC only on 21.01.2009 w.e.f. 2009-2010 after a lapse of almost 3 years between 2006-2007 to 2009-2010. The University retained affiliation, admission of students by State Counseling Board and the latest recognition order despite the institution was having infrastructure and instructional facilities as per norms. The Council came to a conclusion that there was enough justification in accepting the appeal, with a recognition order in continuation of conditional recognition order dated 24.7.2006.

5. AND WHEREAS after perusal of documents, memorandum of appeal, affidavit, VT Report and after hearing oral arguments advanced during the hearing, the Council reiterates the conclusion that there was enough ground to accept the appeal and that it should be accepted. Accordingly, the appeal was accepted and NRC's order dated 21.01.2009 was set aside with direction to the NRC to issue unconditional recognition order in continuation of the conditional recognition order immediately.

6. NOW THEREFORE, the unconditional recognition order is issued in continuation of the conditional recognition order dated 24.7.2006.

7. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.

8. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfilment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed under relevant norms and standards of NCTE for other regulatory bodies like UGC, the State Government etc., wherever applicable.

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10. The Institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Audit Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of account accounts duly issued by a Chartered Accountant together with statement of T.O.S. in respect of the salary etc. in the staff. A copy of the format is enclosed with the order.
11. If the institution continues to do the above according to the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as stipulated provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
12. The Institution shall maintain a separate file with respect to all the provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory documents:
- * Copy of the Application Form;
 - * Land and Building Particulars;
 - * Staff Profile;
 - * Recognition letter;
 - * Information for having fulfilled the norms & standards and other required conditions.
13. In case if the land is in the name of the Society, you must transfer the same within six month to the name of the institution failing to which action shall be taken against the recognition. It shall be essential on the confirmation along with the new land document within the specified time.
