WHEREAS in terms of Section 15(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 Deen Dayal College, 4th KM. Stone, Bhopa Road, Shanti Nagar, Mustafabad, Muzaffar Nagar- 251001, Uttar Pradesh had submitted an application to the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of permission for starting B.Ed Additional Intake Course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 (One Hundred Only) students on 31.12.2004.

AND WHEREAS on scrutiny/perusal of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of report and videography, recommendation of the State Government, the Committee was satisfied that the institution/society fulfills the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the Secondary Teacher Education Programme such as instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, library, accommodation, financial resources, laboratory etc. for running the Programme and has selected/appointed duly qualified teaching staff as per NCTE norms.

AND WHEREAS the matter was placed before the committee in its 141st Meeting held on 22nd to 24th May, 2009 and the committee decides to refuse recognition and return FDRs if submitted. Accordingly refusal order was issued to the institution on 16.07.2009. The above said institution, thereafter preferred an appeal dated 22.06.2009 to the NCTE, New Delhi under section 18 of the NCTE Act 1993 against the aforesaid order.

AND WHEREAS after perusal of documents, memorandum of appeal, affidavit, VT Report and after hearing oral arguments advanced during the hearing, the Council, reached the conclusion that there was adequate ground to accept the appeal, reverse NRC's order dated 16.07.2009, in supersession of the earlier Appellate order dated 07.09.2009, reversed with a direction to the NRC to issue formal recognition order under clause 7(11) of NCTE Regulations immediately.

AND WHEREAS the appeal order dated 16.03.2010 and the original file of the institution along with all other documents, Act of NCTE 1993, Regulations and Guidelines of NCTE published from time to time were considered by the committee in its 162nd meeting held on 24th to 27th June, 2010 and the committee decided to issued letter under clause 7(11) of the Regulations, 2007.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 15(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Northern Regional Committee hereby grants permission to Deen Dayal College, 4th KM. Stone, Bhopa Road, Shanti Nagar, Mustafabad, Muzaffar Nagar- 251001, Uttar Pradesh for conducting an additional unit of 100 seats of B.Ed course of Secondary (Level) of one year duration making the existing annual intake of 100 students to 200 students from the academic session 2009-2010 under clause 7(11) of NCTE Regulations, 2007 notified on 10-12-2007.

- (i) Order for recognition/permission will operate for 2009-2010 only if the requirement of 180 teaching days in the session is fulfilled as per calendar of the University/Affiliating Body.
- (ii) The admissions of students shall be made only after affiliation by the examining body before the commencement of the academic session and the admission of the students shall be completed well before the cut off date prescribed by the examining body for the academic session 2009-2010, failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2010-2011 only.
- (iii) The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund and reserve fund accounts into joint accounts to be operated along with an officer of the Northern Regional Committee.

- (iv) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- (v) The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE Regulations, 2007 notified on 10-12-2007.

Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed under relevant norms and standards of NCTE for other regulatory bodies like UGC, the State Government etc, wherever applicable.

The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant together with statement of T.D.S. in respect of the salary paid to the staff. A copy of the format is enclosed with the order.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as stipulated provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure: -

- Copy of the Application Form
- Land and Building Particulars
- Staff Profile
- Recognition letter
- Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.

In case if the land is in the name of the Society, you must transfer the land within six month in the name of the institution failing to which action shall be initiated to withdraw the recognition. It shall be essential on the part of the institution concerned to get the needful done in this regard and intimate the respective Regional Committee along with the new land document within the stipulated time.
