Whereas in terms of Section 15(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 Dr. Shadi Lal College of Education, Sardhana Road, Meerut- 250001, Uttar Pradesh had submitted an application to the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for starting M.Ed Course of one year duration with an annual intake of 25 (Twenty Five Only) students on 17.07.2006.

And whereas on scrutiny/perusal of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of report and videography, recommendation of the State Government, the Committee was satisfied that the institution/society fulfills the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the Secondary Teacher Education Programme such as instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, library, accommodation, financial resources, laboratory etc. for running the Programme and has selected/appointed duly qualified teaching staff as per NCTE norms.

And whereas the original file of the institution as well as other documents and materials submitted by the institution along with VTR videography were duly considered by the NRC in its 142nd meeting held on 14th to 16th June, 2009, the committee decides to refuse recognition for M.Ed. Accordingly refusal order was issued to the institution on 06.01.2010. The above said institution, thereafter preferred an appeal dated 08.03.2010 to the NCTE, New Delhi under section 18 of the NCTE Act 1993 against the aforesaid order.

And whereas after perusal of documents, memorandum of appeal, VT Report, affidavit and after considering oral arguments advanced during the hearing, the Council, reached the conclusion that there was enough ground to accept the appeal, and that it should be accepted. Accordingly, the appeal was accepted and NRC's order dated 05.01.2010 was reversed vide order no. F.NO. 89-159/2010 Appeal dated 05.05.2010 with a direction to the NRC to issue formal recognition order under clause 7(11) of NCTE Regulations 2007.

And whereas the matter was again placed before the NRC NCTE in its 160th Meeting held on 18th to 20th May 2010 and the committee decided to issued letter under 7(11) of the regulation 2007.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 15(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, **the Northern Regional Committee hereby grants permission to Dr. Shadi Lal College of Education, Sardhana Road, Meerut- 250001, Uttar Pradesh for conducting M.Ed Course of PG (Level) of One year duration with an annual intake of 25 (Twenty Five only) Students from the academic session 2010-2011 under clause 7(11) of NCTE Regulation, 2007 notified on 10-12-2007.**

- (i) The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund and reserve fund accounts into joint accounts to be operated along with an officer of the Northern Regional Committee.
- (ii) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- (iii) The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE Regulations, 2007 notified on 10-12-2007.

Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed under relevant norms and standards of NCTE for other regulatory bodies like UGC, the State Government etc, wherever applicable.

The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant together with statement of T.D.S. in respect of the salary paid to the staff. A copy of the format is enclosed with the order.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as stipulated provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure: -

- Copy of the Application Form
- Land and Building Particulars
- Staff Profile
- Recognition letter
- Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.

In case if the land is in the name of the Society, you must transfer the land within six month in the name of the institution failing to which action shall be initiated to withdraw the recognition. It shall be essential on the part of the institution concerned to get the needful done in this regard and intimate the respective Regional Committee along with the new land document within the stipulated time.
