ORDER

WHEREAS in terms of section 15(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 **Muslima Girl's Degree College, Sir Syed Nagar, (Rehmat Nagar Karula) Moradabad-244001, Uttar Pradesh** had submitted an application to the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for starting additional intake B.Ed Course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 (One Hindered Only) students on 01.09.2006.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before NRC in its 138<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 14<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup> March, 2009 & as per the decision of NRC inspection was conducted on 06.04.2009.

AND WHEREAS, on scrutiny/perusal of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of report and videography the input received from, recommendation of the State Government. The Northern Regional Committee in its 140<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 25<sup>th</sup> to 26<sup>th</sup> April, 2009 decided to issue Show Cause Notice on certain points. Accordingly a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 12.05.2009. & reply of the same was received on 06.05.2010. The case was again considered by NRC in light of order dated 02.05.2009 passed by Hon'ble Height court of Delhi in W.P.(C) 300/2009 and as per decision of NRC the order dated 18.05.2009 was issued to the Institution for refusal the recognition.

AND WHEREAS, the above said Institution, thereafter preferred an appeal before the Council under section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 against the aforesaid order of NRC and the case was remand back to NRC by the Council vide order dated 11.09.2009 with direction to NRC for examination to the file in totality taking into account the reply to the show cause notice and thereafter pass appropriate orders. The case was considered by NRC in its 152<sup>nd</sup> meeting reply and as per decision letter dated 17.12.2009 was issued to the Institution.

AND WHEREAS, the reply of the Institution was placed before NRC in its 157<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on from March, 24<sup>th</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup>, 2010 & Committee decided that letter under clause 7(9) of regulation 2007 be issued. Accordingly a letter of intent under clause 7(9) was issued to the institution on 12.04.2010. & reply of the same was received on 03.06.2010.

AND WHEREAS, the reply of the Institution was placed before NRC in its 160 Meeting held on May, 18<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup>, 2010 & Committee decided to refuse the recognition for B.Ed. additional seats and return FDRs. Accordingly refusal order was issued on 21.06.2010.

AND WHEREAS the above said Institution, thereafter preferred an appeal before the Council under section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 against the aforesaid order of NRC and the case was remand back to NRC by the Council vide order dated 22.09.2010 with direction to NRC for examination of the documents submitted towards the experience and qualification of the faculty and for taking further decision thereafter.

AND WHEREAS, the reply of the Institution was placed before NRC in its 168<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on from October, 05<sup>th</sup> to 08<sup>th</sup>, 2010 & Committee decided that the recognition for 100 additional seats in B.ED. course under clause 7(11) of NCTE Regulation, 2009 be granted to the Institution subject to the following condition :-

- (i) The admission of the students against the additional seats shall be completed well before the cut off date prescribed by the examining body for admission to the academic session 2010-2011 failing which admission for additional seats shall be given from the academic session 2011-2012.
- ii) Formal recognition / permission for additional seats will operate for 2010-2011 only if the requirement of 180 teaching days in the session is fulfilled as per calendar of the University/affiliating body failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 15(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Northern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **Muslima Girl's Degree College, Sir Syed Nagar, (Rehmat Nagar Karula) Moradabad-244001, Uttar Pradesh** for 100 additional seats in B.Ed Course of Secondary (Level) of one year duration from the academic session 2010-2011 under clause 7(11) of NCTE Regulations subject to the following conditions. The total seats will be 200 (100 existing + 100 Additional)

- i) The admission of the students against the additional seats shall be completed well before the cut off date prescribed by the examining body for admission to the academic session 2010-2011 failing which admission for additional seats shall be given from the academic session 2011-2012.

- ii) Formal recognition / permission for additional seats will operate for 2010-2011 only if the requirement of 180 teaching days in the session is fulfilled as per calendar of the University/affiliating body failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012.
- iii) The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund and reserve fund accounts into joint accounts to be operated alongwith an officer of the Northern Regional Committee.
- iv) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- v) The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE Regulations, 2009.

Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed under relevant norms and standards of NCTE for other regulatory bodies like UGC, the State Government etc, wherever applicable.

The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant together with statement of T.D.S. in respect of the salary paid to the staff. A copy of the format is enclosed with the order.

The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure: -

- Copy of the Application Form
- Land and Building Particulars
- Staff Profile
- Recognition letter
- Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.

In case if the land is in the name of the Society, you must transfer the land within six month in the name of the institution failing to which action shall be initiated to withdraw the recognition. It shall be essential on the part of the institution concerned to get the needful done in this regard and intimate the respective Regional Committee along with the new land document within the stipulated time.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made or issued, there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as stipulated provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act 1993
