ORDER

WHEREAS in terms of section 15(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 **Badli Mahavidyalaya, VPO – Amrethi Dadiya, Tehsil – Kadipur, District – Sultanpur-228145, Uttar Pradesh** had submitted an application to the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for starting B.Ed Course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 (One Hindered Only) students on 23.10.2008.

AND WHEREAS, the Inspection of said Institution was conducted on 28.08.2009.

AND WHEREAS, on scrutiny perusal of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of report and videography the input received from, recommendation of the State Government. The Northern Regional Committee in its 149th Meeting held from 13th and 14th September, 2009 decided to issue Show Cause Notice on certain deficiencies. Accordingly show cause notice was issued to the institution on 25.09.2009.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before NRC in its 150th Meeting held from 09th and 11th October, 2009 & committee decided to VT be sent for conduct inspection of the institution for verification of facts of removal of deficiencies and institution be asked to deposit Rs. 40,000/- as inspection fees. The inspection was conducted on 13.01.2010.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before NRC in its 155th Meeting held from 23rd and 25th January, 2010 & as per decision of NRC, recognition was refused vide order dated 29.01.2010.

AND WHEREAS, the above said Institution, thereafter preferred an appeal before the Council under section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 against the aforesaid order of NRC and the case was remanded back to NRC by the Council vide order dated 31.05.2010 with direction to NRC for issuance of letter of intent prior to grant of recognition in respect of institution under section 7(9) of the NCTE Regulations 2009 immediately.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before NRC in its 162nd Meeting held from 24th and 27th June, 2010 & Committee decided to implement the orders of appeal committee. Accordingly letter was issued to the institution on 10.08.2010.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before NRC in its 169th Meeting held from 12th and 13th October, 2010 & decided to issue show cause notice to the institution. Accordingly show cause notice was issued to the Institution on 22.10.2010 & reply of the same was received on 18.10.2010.

AND WHEREAS, the reply of the Institution was placed before NRC in its 171st Meeting held from 28th and 29th October, 2010 & the reply of the institution dated 18.10.2010 w.r.t. letter of intent prior to recognition under section 7(9) of the NCTE Regulation, 2009 has been carefully considered and committee decided that recognition for B.ED. Course under clause 7(11) of NCTE Regulation, 2009 be granted to the Institution subject to the following conditions:-

- i) The admission of students shall be made only after affiliation by the examining body before the commencement of the academic session and the admission of students shall be completed well before the cut off date prescribed by the examining body for the academic session 2010-2011 failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012.
- ii) Formal orders for recognition/permission will operate for 2010-2011 only if the requirement of 180 teaching days in the session is fulfilled as per calendar of the University/Affiliating Body failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Northern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **Badli Mahavidyalaya, VPO – Amrethi Dadiya, Tehsil – Kadipur, District – Sultanpur-228145, Uttar Pradesh** for conducting B.Ed Course with an annual intake of 100 (One hundred Only) students from the academic session 2010-2011 under clause 7(11) of NCTE Regulations subject to the following conditions:

- i) The admission of the students shall be completed well before the cut off date prescribed by the examining body for admission to the academic session 2010-2011 failing which admission for additional seats shall be given from the academic session 2011-2012.
- ii) Formal recognition / permission will operate for 2010-2011 only if the requirement of 180 teaching days in the session is fulfilled as per calendar of the University/affiliating body failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012.

- vi) The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund and reserve fund accounts into joint accounts to be operated alongwith an officer of the Northern Regional Committee.
- iv) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- v) The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE Regulations, 2009.

Further, the recognition is subject to fulfilment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed under relevant norms and standards of NCTE for other regulatory bodies like UGC, the State Government etc, wherever applicable.

The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant together with statement of T.D.S. in respect of the salary paid to the staff. A copy of the format is enclosed with the order.

The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure: -

- Copy of the Application Form
- Land and Building Particulars
- Staff Profile
- Recognition letter
- Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.

In case if the land is in the name of the Society, you must transfer the land within six month in the name of the institution failing to which action shall be initiated to withdraw the recognition. It shall be essential on the part of the institution concerned to get the needful done in this regard and intimate the respective Regional Committee along with the new land document within the stipulated time.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made or issued, there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as stipulated provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act 1993
