ORDER

WHEREAS in terms of section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 M. K. R. P. G. Institute of Technology, Village – Hasonpur Mussoorie, Post – Khekra, Tehsil – Khekra, District – Baghpat – 201101, Uttar Pradesh had submitted an application to the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of permission for B.Ed Course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 (One Hundred Only) students on 29.12.2007.

AND WHEREAS, as per decision taken by NRC in its 139th meeting application was rejected vide order dated 04/08/2009. The institution had preferred an appeal before the Council under section 18 of NCTE, Act, 1993 against the order of NRC. The order of NRC was set – aside by the Council vide order dated 08.10.2009 with direction to NRC for causing inspection of the institution to ascertain the availability of infrastructural and instructional facilities as per NCTE norms and thereafter pass appropriate order. The inspection of the said Institution was conducted on 22.12.2009.

AND WHEREAS, on scrutiny/perusal of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit, input received from the visiting team in the form of report, videography and the input received from recommendation of the State Government, the Northern Regional Committee in its 155th Meeting held from 23rd to 25th January, 2010 & recognition was refused by NRC vide order dated 01.02.2010.

AND WHEREAS, the above said Institution, thereafter preferred an appeal before the Council under section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 against the aforesaid order of NRC and the case was remanded back to NRC by the Council vide order dated 31.05.2010. for issuance of letter of intent prior to grant of recognition in respect of institution under section 7(9) of the NCTE Regulation 2009. The Northern Regional Committee in its 162nd Meeting held from 24th to 27th June, 2010 & decided that implement the orders of appeal committee. Accordingly letter of intent under clause 7(9) was issued to the institution on 21.09.2010.

AND WHEREAS, the reply of the institution received in the office of NRC on 19/08/2010 w.r.t. letter of intent prior to recognition under section 7(9) of the NCTE Regulation, 2009 has been carefully considered by NRC in its 170 Meeting held from 21st and 22nd October, 2010 and committee decided that recognition for B.Ed. Course under clause 7(11) of NCTE Regulation, 2009 be granted to the Institution subject to the following conditions:-

- i) The admission of students shall be made only after affiliation by the examining body before the commencement of the academic session and the admission of students shall be completed well before the cut off date prescribed by the examining body for the academic session 2010-2011 failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012.
- ii) Formal orders for recognition/permission will operate for 2010-2011 only if the requirement of 180 teaching days in the session is fulfilled as per calendar of the University/Affiliating Body failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Northern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to M. K. R. P. G. Institute of Technology, Village – Hasonpur Mussoorie, Post – Khekra, Tehsil – Khekra, District – Baghpat – 201101, Uttar Pradesh for conducting B.Ed Course of Secondary (Level) of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 (One hundred Only) students from the academic session 2010-2011 under clause 7(11) of NCTE Regulations subject to the following conditions:

- i) The admission of the students against additional seats shall be completed well before the cut off date prescribed by the examining body for admission to the academic session 2010-2011 failing which admission for additional seats shall be given from the academic session 2011-2012.
- ii) Formal recognition / permission against additional seats will operate for 2010-2011 only if the requirement of 180 teaching days in the session is fulfilled as per calendar of the University/affiliating body failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012.
- iii) The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund and reserve fund accounts into joint accounts to be operated alongwith an officer of the Northern Regional Committee.

- iv) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- v) The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE Regulations, 2009.

Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed under relevant norms and standards of NCTE for other regulatory bodies like UGC, the State Government etc, wherever applicable.

The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant together with statement of T.D.S. in respect of the salary paid to the staff. A copy of the format is enclosed with the order.


The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure: -

- Copy of the Application Form
- Land and Building Particulars
- Staff Profile
- Recognition letter
- Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.

In case if the land is in the name of the Society, you must transfer the land within six month in the name of the institution failing to which action shall be initiated to withdraw the recognition. It shall be essential on the part of the institution concerned to get the needful done in this regard and intimate the respective Regional Committee along with the new land document within the stipulated time.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made or issued, there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as stipulated provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act 1993
