ORDER

WHEREAS in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 **Career College of Management & Education, Sector- 5, Vikas Nagar, Lucknow, U.P.**, had submitted an application to the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE, Jaipur for grant of recognition/permission for starting **B.Ed Course of One year** duration with an annual intake of **100 ( One Hundred only)** students on **29.12.2006**.

2. AND WHEREAS the original file of the institution as well as other documents and materials submitted by the institution along with VTR videography were duly considered by the NRC in its 118<sup>th</sup> (1<sup>st</sup> Sitting) Meeting held on 16<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup> June, 2007, the committee decided to issue Letter of Conditional Recognition under section 7(11) of NCTE Regulations dated 27.12.2005 for B.ED Course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 (one hundred only) (one unit) subject to the condition of appointment of qualified staff as per NCTE norms through duly constituted selection committee as per the policy of State Govt/ Affiliating University. Accordingly letter was issued to the institution vide letter no. F.NRC/NCTE/UP-2289/2007/22118 dated 20.07.2007. The applicant institution has submitted representation to Northern Regional Committee, NCTE, Jaipur on 08.09.2008. After receiving the representation of institution Letter of Intent Prior to Recognition was issued to the institution vide letter no. F.No.NRC/NCTE/F-7/UP-2289/2008/62406-62407 dated 17.09.2008. The applicant institution has submitted representation to Northern Regional Committee, NCTE, Jaipur on 13.10.2008. After examining the representation of the institution some conditions/ requirements have not been fulfilled by the institution. Accordingly a clarification letter was issued to the institution vide letter no. F.NRC/NCTE/F-7/UP-2289/2006/65843 dated 17.11.2008.

3. AND WHEREAS the applicant institution has not submitted representation to Northern Regional Committee, NCTE, Jaipur. The matter was placed before the Committee in its 134<sup>th</sup> NRC Meeting held on 20<sup>th</sup> to 22<sup>nd</sup> November, 2008 and the Committee decided to issue a clarification to the institution regarding affidavit of Rs. 100 stamp paper from the management of the institution. Accordingly clarification letter was issued to the institution vide letter no. F.NRC/NCTE/F-7/UP-2289/006/66337 dated 02.12.2008. The applicant institution has submitted representation to Northern Regional Committee, NCTE, Jaipur on 10.12.2008. After examining the representation of the institution it is observed that the some conditions/ requirements have not been fulfilled. Accordingly letter was issued to the institution vide letter no. F.NRC/NCTE/F=7/UP-2289/2006/67700 dated 30.12.2008. The applicant institution has submitted representation to Northern Regional Committee, NCTE, Jaipur on 19.01.2009. The Matter was placed before the NRC in its 141<sup>st</sup> Meeting held on 22<sup>nd</sup> to 24<sup>th</sup> May, 2009 and the committee decides to issued a clarification letter accordingly clarification letter was issued to the institution vide letter no. F.NRC/NCTE/F-7/UP-2289/141 Meeting/2009/3328/ dated 01.06.2009.

4. AND WHEREAS the applicant institution has submitted representation to Northern Regional Committee, NCTE, Jaipur on 22.06.2009. The matter was placed before the Committee in its 143<sup>rd</sup> NRC Meeting held on 27<sup>th</sup> to 29<sup>th</sup> June, 2009 and the Committee decided to refuse recognition for B.Ed course. Accordingly refusal order was issued to the institution vide order no. F.NRC/NCTE/F73/UP-2289/143<sup>rd</sup> Meeting/2009/10115-10121 dated 09.09.2009. The above said institution, thereafter preferred an appeal dated 14.10.2009 to the NCTE, New Delhi under section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 against the aforesaid order.

5. AND WHEREAS after perusal of documents, memorandum of appeal, affidavit, VT Report and after considering oral arguments advanced during the presentation, the Council came to the conclusion that there was adequate ground for accepting the appeal and setting aside the NRC's order dated 09.09.2009. Accordingly, the appeal was accepted, the NRC's order dated 09.09.2009 set aside with direction to the NRC to grant recognition to the institution vide its order no. **F.NO. 89-1228/2009 -APPEAL** dated **05.01.2010**.

6. NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Northern Regional Committee hereby grants permission to **Career College of Management & Education, Sector- 5, Vikas Nagar, Lucknow, U.P.** for conducting **B.ED course of Secondary (Level) of One year** duration with an annual intake of **100 Students (One Hundred only)** students from the academic session **2009-2010** under clause 7(11) of NCTE Regulation, 2007 notified on 10-12-2007 subject to fulfillment of the following conditions as per the clarification from the NCTE HQtrs letter No. File No. 48-3(1)/2008/NCTE (N&S) dated 01/10/2009:

**I. The admissions of students shall be made only after affiliation by the examining body before the commencement of the academic session and the admission of the students shall be completed well before the cut off date prescribed by the examining body for the academic session 2009-2010, failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2010-2011 only.**

**II. Formal orders for recognition/permission will operate for 2009-2010 only if the requirement of 180 teaching days in the session is fulfilled as per calendar of the University/Affiliating Body.**

7. The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund and reserve fund accounts into joint accounts to be operated along with an officer of the Northern Regional Committee.

8. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.

9. The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE Regulations, 2007 notified on 10-12-2007.

10. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfilment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed under relevant norms and standards of NCTE for other regulatory bodies like UGC, the State Government etc, wherever applicable.

11. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant together with statement of T.D.S. in respect of the salary paid to the staff. A copy of the format is enclosed with the order.

12. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as stipulated provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

13. The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure: -

- Copy of the Application Form
- Land and Building Particulars
- Staff Profile
- Recognition letter
- Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.

14. In case if the land is in the name of the Society, you must transfer the land within six month in the name of the institution failing to which action shall be initiated to withdraw the recognition. It shall be essential on the part of the institution concerned to get the needful done in this regard and intimate the respective Regional Committee along with the new land document within the stipulated time.
