WHEREAS in terms of Section **14(1)** of the NCTE Act, 1993 **Royal Educational Institute, 28th K.M. Stone, NH – 24, Delhi Hapur Bypass, Dasna, Distt. – Ghaziabad, Uttar Pradesh** had submitted an application to the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE, Jaipur for grant of recognition/permission for starting **B.Ed** Course of **One year** duration with an annual intake of **100 (One Hundred Only)** students on **30.12.2005**

2. AND WHEREAS the original file of the institution as well as other documents and materials submitted by the institution along with VTR videography were duly considered by the NRC in its **112th Meeting held on 27th to 28th December, 2006** the committee decided to issue conditional recognition order to the institution and accordingly conditional recognition order was issued vide NCTE letter no. **F.NRC/NCTE/F-7/2007/14445-47 Dated 23.02.2007.**

3. AND WHEREAS the applicant institution had not been submitted its representation to Northern Regional Committee, a letter for compliance to the conditional recognition order was issued to the institution on 06.07.2007. The institution did not make reply to our letter dated 06.07.2007. The matter was placed before NRC in its 141st Meeting held on 22nd – 24th May 2009 and the committee decided to refuse the recognition for B.Ed. Course of one year duration. Accordingly order was issued vide order no. F.NO. NRC/NCTE/F-7/UP-2037/141 Meeting/2009/11972-11978 dated 04.11.2009. The above said institution, thereafter preferred an appeal dated 06.11.2009 to the NCTE, New Delhi. Under section 18 of the NCTE Act 1993 against the aforesaid order.

4. AND WHEREAS after perusal of documents, memorandum of appeal, affidavit and after hearing oral arguments advanced during the hearing, the NCTE, New Delhi, reached the conclusion that there was adequate ground to accept the appeal, and set-aside NRC's order dated 04.11.2009 and with the direction to the NRC to grant formal recognition to the institution within 15 days of issue of this order in its order no. F.NO. 89-1309/2009 APPEAL/A 11772 dated 05.03.2010.

5. NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section **14(3) (a)** of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Northern Regional Committee hereby grants permission to **Royal Educational Institute, 28th K.M. Stone, NH – 24, Delhi Hapur Bypass, Dasna, Distt. – Ghaziabad, Uttar Pradesh** for conducting **B.Ed** Course of **Secondary (Level)** of **One year** duration with an annual intake of **100 Students (One Hundred only)** students from the academic session **2009-2010** under clause 7(11) of NCTE Regulation, 2007 notified on 10-12-2007 subject to fulfillment of the following conditions as per the clarification from the NCTE HQtrs letter No. File No. 48-3(1)/2008/NCTE (N&S) dated 01/10/2009:

I. The admissions of students shall be made only after affiliation by the examining body before the commencement of the academic session and the admission of the students shall be completed well before the cut off date prescribed by the examining body for the academic session 2009-2010, failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2010-2011 only.

II. Formal orders for recognition/permission will operate for 2009-2010 only if the requirement of 180 teaching days in the session is fulfilled as per calendar of the University/Affiliating Body.

6. The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund and reserve fund accounts into joint accounts to be operated along with an officer of the Northern Regional Committee.

7. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.

8. The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE Regulations, 2007 notified on 10-12-2007.

9. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed under relevant norms and standards of NCTE for other regulatory bodies like UGC, the State Government etc, wherever applicable.


10. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant together with statement of T.D.S. in respect of the salary paid to the staff. A copy of the format is enclosed with the order.


11. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as stipulated provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

12. The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure: -

- Copy of the Application Form
- Land and Building Particulars
- Staff Profile
- Recognition letter
- Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.

13. In case if the land is in the name of the Society, you must transfer the land within six month in the name of the institution failing to which action shall be initiated to withdraw the recognition. It shall be essential on the part of the institution concerned to get the needful done in this regard and intimate the respective Regional Committee along with the new land document within the stipulated time.
