ORDER

WHEREAS, in terms of section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, **SHREE SAI COLLEGE OF EDUCATION & TECHNOLOGY, B-74, TAKSHILA COLONY, GARH ROAD, POST MEDICAL COLLEGE, DISTT. MEERUT-250004, UTTAR PRADESH** had submitted an application to the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for starting B.Ed. Course of One year duration with an annual intake of 100 (One hundred Only) students on 03.01.2008.

AND WHEREAS, the Inspection of the said institution under section 14 was conducted by visiting team on 12.10.2008. The report of the visiting team was considered by NRC in its 137th Meeting held on 28th February & 1st March, 2009 and NRC decided that the Institution does not fulfill the requirement of NCTE Regulations and Norms & Standards prescribed by NCTE, for B.Ed. Course, hence show cause Notice under the provision of Section 14(3) (b) of NCTE Act, 1993 be issued to the Institution before issue of refusal order. Accordingly, show cause notice was issued to the institution on 12.03.2009.

AND WHEREAS, the reply received in response to show cause notice was considered by NRC in its 140th Meeting held on April 25-26, 2009, and the committee directs the Institute to submit the approved building plan indicating dimensions of rooms and hall clearly as from the submitted approved building plan the dimensions of rooms and hall are not readable. Accordingly, letter issued on 19.05.2009.

AND WHEREAS, the reply received in response to the aforesaid letter was considered by NRC in its 141st Meeting held from May 22-24, 2009 and the Committee decided to issue letter under clause 7(9) of regulations 2007 subject to the submission of resolution of Jila Panchayat regarding approval of building plan. Accordingly, letter was issued on 30.05.2009.

AND WHEREAS, the reply received in response to the aforesaid letter was considered by NCTE in its 142nd Meeting held from June 14-16, 2009 & the Committee decided to issue letter thereby directing institution to submit the clarification. Accordingly, letter was issued on 23.06.2009.

AND WHEREAS, the reply received in response to the aforesaid letter was considered by NRC in its 143rd meeting held from June 27-29, 2009, and the Committee decided to refuse recognition to the institution. Accordingly, order was issued on 23.07.2009.

AND WHEREAS, the above said Institution, thereafter preferred an appeal dated 26.08.2009 to the NCTE, New Delhi under section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 against the aforesaid order. The Council came to the conclusion that there is adequate ground to accept the appeal and set-aside NRC's order dated 23.07.2009 and remanded back the case to NRC vide order dated 06.11.2009 for issuance of letter of intent prior to recognition under clause 7(9) of the NCTE Regulations 2009. Accordingly, letter was issued on 16.12.2009.

AND WHEREAS, the reply received in response to letter of intent was considered by NCTE in its 156th Meeting held on February 22-23, 2010 & the Committee decided to issue letter thereby directing institution to submit the clarification. Accordingly, letter was issued on 08.03.2010.

AND WHEREAS, the reply received in response to the aforesaid letter was considered by NRC in its 157th meeting held from March 24-27, 2010, and the Committee decided to issue show cause notice to the institution. Accordingly, letter was issued on 12.04.2010.

AND WHEREAS, the reply received in response to show cause notice was considered by NRC in its 160th meeting held from May 18-20, 2010, and the committee decided to direct the Institute to remove certain deficiencies within 90 days. Accordingly, letter issued on 01.06.2010.

AND WHEREAS, reply received on 27.08.2010 was placed in the 168th Meeting held from October 5-8, 2010 and the committee decided to issue letter thereby directing the institute to submit clarification. Accordingly, letter issued on 26.10.2010 on the following grounds:-

- The Principal earlier selected has been replaced by a new Principal, who possess the requisite qualification and experience as per NCTE norms. However, his appointment is yet to be approved by the University.
- The three teachers selected earlier have been replaced by three new teachers having requisite qualifications but their appointment has not been approved by the University as required under section 7(9) and 7(11) of the NCTE Regulations 2009

AND WHEREAS, the reply dated 19.11.2010 has been considered by NRC in its 175th Meeting held on December 30-31, 2010 and found satisfactory. The institution submitted approval of the C.C.S. University vide this letter dated 16.11.2010 for appointment of faculty. Hence, the NRC decided to issue recognition to the institution for B.Ed. course with an annual intake of 100 students under clause 7(11) of NCTE Regulations 2009 and in terms of section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993 subject to the usual terms and conditions.

AND WHEREAS, the NCTE has issued letter No.48-6/PT-III/ NCTE (N&S) dated 31.08.2010 in which it was stated that the matter regarding issue of recognition order under clause 7(9) or 7(11) of NCTE Regulations to the institution which were found eligible for grant of recognition order on merit but where order could not be issued due to the ban imposed by the NCTE on 26th July, 2009 has been considered by the Council and it is clarified that such pending orders now be issued. This is due to the consideration that the present ban is only on fresh receipt of application for the academic session 2011-2012 and therefore the old pending cases are to be disposed on merit without any reference to the ban.

AND WHEREAS, the above letter of NCTE, Headquarter was considered by NRC in its 166th Meeting held on 9th September, 2010 and NRC decided that the recognition order under section 7 (11) of NCTE, Regulations in all such pending cases where NRC or Council (NCTE) had decided to grant recognition under section 7 (11) of NCTE Regulations be issued from the session 2010-2011 subject to the following condition:-

- The admission of students shall be made only after affiliation by the examining body before the commencement of the academic session and the admission of students shall be completed well before the cut off date prescribed by the examining body for the academic session 2010-2011 failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012.
- Formal orders for recognition/permission will operate for 2010-2011 only if the requirement of 180 teaching days in the session is fulfilled as per calendar of the University/Affiliating Body failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Northern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **SHREE SAI COLLEGE OF EDUCATION & TECHNOLOGY, B-74, TAKSHILA COLONY, GARH ROAD, POST MEDICAL COLLEGE, DISTT. MEERUT-250004, UTTAR PRADESH** for conducting B.Ed Course of Secondary (Level) of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 (One hundred Only) students from the academic session 2010-2011 under clause 7(11) of NCTE Regulations subject to the following conditions:-

- The admission of students shall be made only after affiliation by the examining body before the commencement of the academic session and the admission of students shall be completed well before the cut off date prescribed by the examining body for the academic session 2010-2011 failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012.
- Formal orders for recognition/permission will operate for 2010-2011 only if the requirement of 180 teaching days in the session is fulfilled as per calendar of the University/Affiliating Body failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012.
- The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund and reserve fund accounts into joint accounts to be operated along with an officer of the Northern Regional Committee.
