ORDER

WHEREAS, in terms of section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, **KASHI NATH MAHAVIDYALAYA, PLOT NO.297/299/300, VILL-NARAYANPUR KAKARAH, POST-DAULATPUR, TEHSIL SAIDPUR, DISTT. GHAZIPUR, UTTAR PRADESH** had submitted an application to the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for starting B.Ed. Course of One year duration with an annual intake of 100 (One hundred Only) students on 31.10.2008.

AND WHEREAS, the inspection of the institution under section 14 was conducted on 30.07.2009.

AND WHEREAS, the original file of the institution, VTR along with all other related documents, Act of NCTE, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines of NCTE published from time to time were considered by the committee in its 147<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on August 16-17, 2009 and the committee decided to issue Show cause notice before refusing the recognition to the institution. Accordingly, Show-cause notice issued to the institution on 20.08.2009 on the following grounds:-

- o There are no specific labs for B.Ed. course.
- o Science labs of school are proposed to be shared with the B.Ed. course.
- o As per CD, the computers are not sufficient for 100 B.Ed. students.
- o Play grounds do not exist.
- o As per CD, toilets are poorly maintained.
- o Language learning facilities are not available.
- o The number of titles in the library is not as per NCTE norms.
- o The information as required per NCTE Regulation, 2007 is not available on the College Website.

AND WHEREAS, the original file of the institution, reply of the Institution along with all other related documents, Act of NCTE, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines of NCTE published from time to time were considered by the committee in its 148<sup>th</sup> Meeting held from August 28-30, 2009 and the committee decided for re-inspection of the Institution.

AND WHEREAS, the re-inspection of the institution under section 14 was conducted on 19.09.2009.

AND WHEREAS, the original file of the institution, VT Report along with all other related documents, Act of NCTE, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines of NCTE published from time to time were considered by the committee in its 150<sup>th</sup> meeting held from October 09-11, 2009 and the committee decided to issue letter under clause 7(9) of Regulations 2007. Accordingly, Letter of intent prior to recognition issued to the institution on 30.10.2009.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was considered by NRC in its 156<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on February 22-23, 2010 and the committee decided to close the file. Accordingly, refusal order issued on 08.03.2010 on the following grounds:-

- o The reply of the Institute has not been received in stipulated till date.

AND WHEREAS, the above said Institution, thereafter preferred an appeal dated 07.04.2010 to the NCTE, New Delhi under section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 against the aforesaid order. The Council reached the conclusion that there was adequate ground to accept the appeal, set aside NRC's order dated 08-03-10 and remanded the case to NRC for issuing show cause notice and for taking appropriate decision, thereafter. The final decision of the NRC, if it decides to grant recognition would, however, be made operative from the date of withdrawal of the ban on further recognition of B.Ed. course in the State of Uttar Pradesh imposed by the NCTE and notified vide Public Notice dated 28-07-09.

AND WHEREAS, the said appeal order was considered by NRC in its 162<sup>nd</sup> Meeting held from June 24-27, 2010 and it was decided to direct the institution to submit the list of appointed Faculty along with photocopies of all certificates within 30 days. Accordingly, letter issued to the institution on 27.07.2010

AND WHEREAS, the reply of the institution dated 29.11.2010 has been carefully considered by NRC in its 175<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on December 30-31, 2010 and found the documents in order. In view of the approval of the university, minutes of the Selection Committee comprising of experts of University nominee, it was decided to issue recognition to the institution for B.Ed. course with an annual intake of 100 students under clause 7(11) of NCTE Regulations 2009 and in terms of section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993 subject to the usual terms and conditions.

AND WHEREAS, the NCTE has issued letter No.48-6/PT-III/ NCTE (N&S) dated 31.08.2010 in which it was stated that the matter regarding issue of recognition order under clause 7(9) or 7(11) of NCTE Regulations to the institution which were found eligible for grant of recognition order on merit but where order could not be issued due to the ban imposed by the NCTE on 26<sup>th</sup> July, 2009 has been considered by the Council and it is clarified that such pending orders now be issued. This is due to the consideration that the present ban is only on fresh receipt of application for the academic session 2011-2012 and therefore the old pending cases are to be disposed on merit without any reference to the ban.

AND WHEREAS, the above letter of NCTE, Headquarter was considered by NRC in its 166<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 9<sup>th</sup> September, 2010 and NRC decided that the recognition order under section 7 (11) of NCTE, Regulations in all such pending cases where NRC or Council (NCTE) had decided to grant recognition under section 7 (11) of NCTE Regulations be issued from the session 2010-2011 subject to the following condition:-

- The admission of students shall be made only after affiliation by the examining body before the commencement of the academic session and the admission of students shall be completed well before the cut off date prescribed by the examining body for the academic session 2010-2011 failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012.
- Formal orders for recognition/permission will operate for 2010-2011 only if the requirement of 180 teaching days in the session is fulfilled as per calendar of the University/Affiliating Body failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Northern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **KASHI NATH MAHAVIDYALAYA, PLOT NO.297/299/300, VILL-NARAYANPUR KAKARAH, POST-DAULATPUR, TEHSIL SAIDPUR, DISTT. GHAZIPUR, UTTAR PRADESH** for conducting B.Ed Course of Secondary (Level) of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 (One hundred Only) students from the academic session 2010-2011 under clause 7(11) of NCTE Regulations subject to the following conditions:-

- The admission of students shall be made only after affiliation by the examining body before the commencement of the academic session and the admission of students shall be completed well before the cut off date prescribed by the examining body for the academic session 2010-2011 failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012.
- Formal orders for recognition/permission will operate for 2010-2011 only if the requirement of 180 teaching days in the session is fulfilled as per calendar of the University/Affiliating Body failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012.
- The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund and reserve fund accounts into joint accounts to be operated along with an officer of the Northern Regional Committee.
- The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE Regulations, 2007 notified on 10-12-2007.

Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed under relevant norms and standards of NCTE for other regulatory bodies like UGC, the State Government etc, wherever applicable.

The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant together with statement of T.D.S. in respect of the salary paid to the staff. A copy of the format is enclosed with the order.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as stipulated provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure: -

- Copy of the Application Form
- Land and Building Particulars
- Staff Profile
- Recognition letter
- Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.

In case if the land is in the name of the Society, you must transfer the land within six month in the name of the institution failing to which action shall be initiated to withdraw the recognition. It shall be essential on the part of the institution concerned to get the needful done in this regard and intimate the respective Regional Committee along with the new land document within the stipulated time.
