ORDER

WHEREAS, in terms of section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, **Shivlok Shrinet Mahavidyalaya, Plot No.792, 803 (Kh), Parari, Mirzapur, Vill- Kapsaur, Post- Parari, Tehsil- Sadar, District- Mirzapur-231001, Uttar Pradesh** had submitted an application to the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for starting B.Ed. Course of One year duration with an annual intake of 100 (One hundred Only) students on 30.10.2008.

AND WHEREAS, the original file of the institution, reply of deficiency letter and all other related documents were considered by the NRC in its 139<sup>th</sup> meeting held from April 10-12, 2009 and the committee decided to close the file and return FDRs. Accordingly, closure order issued to the institution on 10.06.2009.

AND WHEREAS, the above said Institution, thereafter preferred an appeal dated 22.06.2009 to the NCTE, New Delhi under section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 against the aforesaid order. The Council came to the conclusion that there is adequate ground to accept the appeal and set-aside NRC's order dated 10.06.2009 and remand back the case to NRC vide order dated 07.08.2009 for reconsideration of the case.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed in the 148<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on August 28-30, 2009 and it was decided to seek guidance from CP, HQ. Accordingly, letter issued to NCTE hqrs. on 28.08.2009

AND WHEREAS, the said institution filed a Writ Petition No. 25541 / 09 in the Hon'ble High Court Of Allahabad, Uttar Pradesh. Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Allahabad, Uttar Pradesh passed an order dated 18.05.2009 which was placed in the 154<sup>th</sup> Meeting held from January 09-11, 2010 and it was decided to issue letter under clause 7(9) of regulations 2007. Accordingly, Letter of intent prior to recognition issued on 18.01.2010. NRC in its 155<sup>th</sup> meeting held from January 23-25, 2010 decided to modify the decision taken by NRC in its 154<sup>th</sup> Meeting held from January 09-11, 2010 in respect of the said institution, and the decision may be read as VT be constituted.

AND WHEREAS, the Inspection of the said institution under section 14 was conducted by visiting team on 28.05.2010. The report of the visiting team was considered by NRC in its 162<sup>nd</sup> Meeting held from June 24-27, 2010 and NRC decided that the Institution does not fulfill the requirement of NCTE Regulations and Norms & Standards prescribed by NCTE, for B.Ed. Course, hence show cause Notice under the provision of Section 14(3) (b) of NCTE Act, 1993 be issued to the Institution before issue of refusal order. Accordingly, Show-cause notice issued to the institution on 21.07.2010.

AND WHEREAS, reply received in response to Show-cause notice was placed in the 168<sup>th</sup> Meeting held from October 5-8, 2010 and it was again decided to issue show cause notice to the institution. Accordingly, Show-cause notice issued to the institution on 22.10.2010 on the following grounds:-

- The appointment of principal is not as per NCTE norms. Shri Ram Kripal Singh appointed as principal on regular basis has already attained the age of superannuation. Only a retired Professor of Education/HOD Education can be appointed in the event of non-availability of suitable person upto the age of 65 years. Shri Yadav is not a retired Professor or HOD. The institution be asked to appoint a Principal as per NCTE norms.
- The faculty appointment is not as per NCTE norms. Whereas it has appointed one lecturer extra, having a Master degree in Education (MA in Education), out of the remaining 7 lecturers, three possess M.A. (Education). As per NCTE norms only one lecturer can have a MA (Education) qualification and remaining six should possess a M.Ed. qualification. Only four of the faculty appointment in the institution possess a M.Ed. qualification.

- The institution has not yet built up its science lab properly, despite its explanation in letter dated 08.07.2010, supported by photographs. The science lab should have proper experimental table with water arrangement and in built sink.

AND WHEREAS, the reply of the institution dated 21.11.2010 w.r.t. show cause notice dated 22.10.2010 has been considered by NRC in its 175<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on December 30-31, 2010. The reply has been found satisfactory in view of fresh appointments of lecturers with the approval of the University and removal of deficiencies in the labs as shown in the photographs and the NRC, therefore decided to issue recognition to the institution for B.Ed. course with an annual intake of 100 students under clause 7(11) of NCTE Regulations 2009 and in terms of section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993 subject to the usual terms and conditions.

AND WHEREAS, the NCTE has issued letter No.48-6/PT-III/ NCTE (N&S) dated 31.08.2010 in which it was stated that the matter regarding issue of recognition order under clause 7(9) or 7(11) of NCTE Regulations to the institution which were found eligible for grant of recognition order on merit but where order could not be issued due to the ban imposed by the NCTE on 26<sup>th</sup> July, 2009 has been considered by the Council and it is clarified that such pending orders now be issued. This is due to the consideration that the present ban is only on fresh receipt of application for the academic session 2011-2012 and therefore the old pending cases are to be disposed on merit without any reference to the ban.

AND WHEREAS, the above letter of NCTE, Headquarter was considered by NRC in its 166<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 9<sup>th</sup> September, 2010 and NRC decided that the recognition order under section 7 (11) of NCTE, Regulations in all such pending cases where NRC or Council (NCTE) had decided to grant recognition under section 7 (11) of NCTE Regulations be issued from the session 2010-2011 subject to the following condition:-

- The admission of students shall be made only after affiliation by the examining body before the commencement of the academic session and the admission of students shall be completed well before the cut off date prescribed by the examining body for the academic session 2010-2011 failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012.
- Formal orders for recognition/permission will operate for 2010-2011 only if the requirement of 180 teaching days in the session is fulfilled as per calendar of the University/Affiliating Body failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Northern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **Shivlok Shrinet Mahavidyalaya, Plot No.792, 803 (Kh), Parari, Mirzapur, Vill- Kapsaur, Post- Parari, Tehsil- Sadar, District- Mirzapur-231001, Uttar Pradesh** for conducting B.Ed Course of Secondary (Level) of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 (One hundred Only) students from the academic session 2010-2011 under clause 7(11) of NCTE Regulations subject to the following conditions:-

- The admission of students shall be made only after affiliation by the examining body before the commencement of the academic session and the admission of students shall be completed well before the cut off date prescribed by the examining body for the academic session 2010-2011 failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012.
- Formal orders for recognition/permission will operate for 2010-2011 only if the requirement of 180 teaching days in the session is fulfilled as per calendar of the University/Affiliating Body failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012.
- The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund and reserve fund accounts into joint accounts to be operated along with an officer of the Northern Regional Committee.
- The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE Regulations, 2007 notified on 10-12-2007.

Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed under relevant norms and standards of NCTE for other regulatory bodies like UGC, the State Government etc, wherever applicable.

The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant together with statement of T.D.S. in respect of the salary paid to the staff. A copy of the format is enclosed with the order.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as stipulated provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure: -

- Copy of the Application Form
- Land and Building Particulars
- Staff Profile
- Recognition letter
- Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.

In case if the land is in the name of the Society, you must transfer the land within six month in the name of the institution failing to which action shall be initiated to withdraw the recognition. It shall be essential on the part of the institution concerned to get the needful done in this regard and intimate the respective Regional Committee along with the new land document within the stipulated time.
