WHEREAS, in terms of section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, Veer Kunwar Degree College, Plot No.165/166/167/168, Nagina, Road, VPO- Bijnor, Tehsil- Bijnor, Distt- Bijnor-246701, Uttar Pradesh had submitted an application to the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for starting B.Ed. Course of One year duration with an annual intake of 100 (One hundred Only) students on 26.08.2008.

AND WHEREAS, the original file of the institution, along with all other related documents, Act of NCTE, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines of NCTE published from time to time were considered by the committee in its 145<sup>th</sup> Meeting held from July 26-28, 2009 and the committee decided to close the file and return FDRs. Accordingly, closure order issued on 12.08.2009 on the following grounds:-

- The deficiencies communicated to the Institution still exist.

AND WHEREAS, the above said Institution, thereafter preferred an appeal dated 03.09.2009 to the NCTE, New Delhi under section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 against the aforesaid order. The Council came to the conclusion that there is adequate ground to accept the appeal and remanded back the case to NRC vide order dated 06.11.2009 for causing inspection.

AND WHEREAS, the inspection of the said institution under section 14 was conducted by visiting team on 02.02.2010.

AND WHEREAS, the VTR was considered by NRC in its 159<sup>th</sup> meeting held from April 28-May-01, 2010 and the committee decided to issue show cause notice to the institution. Accordingly, Show-cause notice issued to the institution on 14.05.2010 on the following grounds:-

- The land is not in the name of the Institute.
- Building plan do not indicate khasra number / plot number.
- Proper Science lab does not exist as the apparatus are displayed on the table.
- As per the CD, it appears that many courses are being run in the same premise using same infrastructure. This information has been counseled.

AND WHEREAS, the original file of the institution, reply of the Institution along with all other related documents, Act of NCTE, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines of NCTE published from time to time were considered by the committee in its 162<sup>nd</sup> Meeting held from June 24-27, 2010 and the committee decided to issue Letter of intent prior to recognition under clause 7(9) of regulations 2007. Accordingly, Letter of intent prior to recognition order issued on 16.07.2010.

AND WHEREAS, the reply dated 19/07/2010 submitted by the institution was considered by NRC in its 173<sup>rd</sup> Meeting held from November 24-26, 2010 and it was decided that clarification on the following points be sought from the institution for further consideration of the case. Accordingly, clarification letter issued on 16.12.2010 on the following points:-

- The Institution has submitted list of faculty duly approved by the University. However, a copy of the minutes of the Selection Committee has not been submitted.

AND WHEREAS, the reply dated nil received on 9.12.2010 was considered by NRC in its 175<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on December 30-31, 2010 and it was decided that recognition be granted to the institution for B.Ed. course with an annual intake of 100 students, under clause 7(11) of NCTE Regulations 2009 and in terms of section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993 subject to the usual terms and conditions.

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AND WHEREAS, the NCTE has issued letter No.48-6/PT-III/ NCTE (N&S) dated 31.08.2010 in which it was stated that the matter regarding issue of recognition order under clause 7(9) or 7(11) of NCTE Regulations to the institution which were found eligible for grant of recognition order on merit but where order could not be issued due to the ban imposed by the NCTE on 26<sup>th</sup> July, 2009 has been considered by the Council and it is clarified that such pending orders now be issued. This is due to the consideration that the present ban is only on fresh receipt of application for the academic session 2011-2012 and therefore the old pending cases are to be disposed on merit without any reference to the ban.

AND WHEREAS, the above letter of NCTE, Headquarter was considered by NRC in its 166<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 9<sup>th</sup> September, 2010 and NRC decided that the recognition order under section 7 (11) of NCTE, Regulations in all such pending cases where NRC or Council (NCTE) had decided to grant recognition under section 7 (11) of NCTE Regulations be issued from the session 2010-2011 subject to the following condition:-

- The admission of students shall be made only after affiliation by the examining body before the commencement of the academic session and the admission of students shall be completed well before the cut off date prescribed by the examining body for the academic session 2010-2011 failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012.
- Formal orders for recognition/permission will operate for 2010-2011 only if the requirement of 180 teaching days in the session is fulfilled as per calendar of the University/Affiliating Body failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Northern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to Veer Kunwar Degree College, Plot No.165/166/167/168, Nagina, Road, VPO- Bijnor, Tehsil- Bijnor, Distt- Bijnor-246701, Uttar Pradesh for conducting B.Ed Course of Secondary (Level) of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 (One hundred Only) students from the academic session 2010-2011 under clause 7(11) of NCTE Regulations subject to the following conditions:-

- The admission of students shall be made only after affiliation by the examining body before the commencement of the academic session and the admission of students shall be completed well before the cut off date prescribed by the examining body for the academic session 2010-2011 failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012.
- Formal orders for recognition/permission will operate for 2010-2011 only if the requirement of 180 teaching days in the session is fulfilled as per calendar of the University/Affiliating Body failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012.
- The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund and reserve fund accounts into joint accounts to be operated along with an officer of the Northern Regional Committee.
- The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE Regulations, 2007 notified on 10-12-2007.

Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed under relevant norms and standards of NCTE for other regulatory bodies like UGC, the State Government etc, wherever applicable.

The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant together with statement of T.D.S. in respect of the salary paid to the staff. A copy of the format is enclosed with the order.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as stipulated provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

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The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure: -

- Copy of the Application Form
- Land and Building Particulars
- Staff Profile
- Recognition letter
- Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.

In case if the land is in the name of the Society, you must transfer the land within six month in the name of the institution failing to which action shall be initiated to withdraw the recognition. It shall be essential on the part of the institution concerned to get the needful done in this regard and intimate the respective Regional Committee along with the new land document within the stipulated time.
