RECOGNITION ORDER

6 FEB 2017

WHEREAS in terms of section 14(1)/15(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the institutions had submitted applications to the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition/permission for Teacher Education Courses.

2. AND WHEREAS on scrutiny/perusal, veracity of the facts & figures as per the application submitted by the institutions mentioned in table below, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of visiting team report including videography and also the reply submitted by the institution against decision of clause 7(13) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014, the Northern Regional Committee in its meeting held from time to time (mentioned against each of the institution) is satisfied that the institution/society fulfils the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the concerned Teacher Education Programme such as instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, library, accommodation, financial resources, laboratory, etc. for running the programme and has selected/appointed duly qualified teaching staff as per NCTE norms and as per the approval of faculty given by the affiliating bodies.

3. NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a)/15(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Northern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition/permission to the following Institutions for conducting Teacher Education programme with an annual intake mentioned against their names from the academic session 2017-2018 under clause 7(16) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014 subject to fulfilment of the conditions mentioned below: -

4. The institutions shall adhere to the fulfillment of the provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 and ensure the following before commencement of the session: -

- The institution shall comply with various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
- The institution shall comply with the condition as laid down in the clause 8(3) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 which provided that "An institution which has been recognized by the Council shall obtain accreditation from an accrediting agency approved by Council within five years of such recognition."
- The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.
- The Norms of Staff/qualifications/administrative and professional staff/terms and conditions of service etc. shall be as per the provisions of NCTE Regulations, 2014.



5. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfilment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, the State Government etc. as applicable and compliance of the following by the affiliating body, State Govt and also the concerned recognised Institution: -

- (i) The affiliating bodies/State Govt. shall be required to verify the authenticity of the land & building documents with the required land & built up area as well as appointment of requisite teaching & non-teaching staff as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 by the concerned institution before grant of affiliation to an institution.
- (ii) The affiliating body shall ensure that the institution is composite institution as per the definition of composite institution given in the NCTE Regulation, 2014. If at any stage, it is found that the institution as not a composite institution, the recognition, granted will be treated as withdrawn and the sole responsibility of the same will be of the institution. However, in the existing institutions permitted for additional intake, shall have to ensure that they are to become composite gradually preferably the academic session 2016-17.
- (iii) The NOC of the affiliating body and staff approval thereof submitted by the institution, if found fake at any stage, the recognition, granted will be treated as withdrawn and the sole responsibility of the same will be of the institution.

6. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

7. The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure: -

- (i) Copy of the Application Form
- (ii) Land and Building Particulars
- (iii) Staff Profile
- (iv) Recognition letter
- (v) Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.

8. In case if the land is in the name of the Society/trust, the land is to be transferred within six months in the name of the institution, failing which action shall be initiated to withdraw the recognition. It shall be essential on the part of the institution concerned to get the needful done in this regard and intimate about the same to the respective Regional Committee along with the new land documents within the stipulated time.


9. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

10. The Educational Institution shall follow Uniform Accounting System as brought out by ICAI and accepted by MHRD.

11. The Institution shall fill the GIS Application within one month of issue of this order.

12. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the order, it may prefer an appeal under sections 18 of NCTE Act, 1993 in the "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte.india.org within 60 days from the date of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.

ORDER

WHEREAS, in terms of section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, **Brahaspati Mahila Mahavidyalaya, 50, K Block, Kidwai Nagar, Kanpur-208011, Uttar Pradesh** was granted recognition for **B.Ed.** Course of **one year** duration with an annual intake of 100 students on **03.07.2007**.

AND WHEREAS, the inspection of the institution was conducted on 31.03.2009 under section 17 of the NCTE Act 1993. Northern Regional Committee in its **139th meeting held on April 10-12, 2009**, after considering the report of the visiting team as well as other relevant materials furnished by the applicant institution was satisfied that the applicant institution does not fulfill the requirements and issued a show-cause notice on 19.05.2009 to the applicant institution under proviso to section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 thereby giving an opportunity to the said applicant institution to make a written representation in this behalf.

AND WHEREAS, the applicant institution has submitted representation on 16.06.2009. The original file of the institution as well as other documents and VTR were again duly considered by Northern Regional Committee in its **153rd Meeting held on December 11-12, 2009** which came to the conclusion that recognition to the said institution be withdrawn. Accordingly, withdrawal order issued on 06.01.2010 for the following reasons:-

- The Faculty still has not been appointed as per NCTE norms for B.Ed.
 - Approved earmarked building map still has not been submitted.
 - Still the computers are not sufficient for 100 students.
 - The Language learning lab still ill equipped.
 - EPF still has not been maintained.
- The library does not have number of titles as per NCTE norms for B.Ed.

AND WHEREAS, the above said Institution, thereafter preferred an appeal dated **14.01.2010** to the NCTE, New Delhi under section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 against the aforesaid order.

AND WHEREAS, after perusal of documents, Memorandum of appeal, affidavit and VT Report, and considering oral arguments advanced during the hearing, the Council came to the conclusion that there was no ground to accept the appeal and NRC's order dated **06.01.2010** was confirmed vide Council's order dated **05.03.2010**.

AND WHEREAS, the said institution aggrieved by the order of the Council filed a writ petition No. 18232/2010 before the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Allahabad. The Hon'ble High Court in their order dt. 06.04.10, holding that the show cause notice does indicate that the ground which has been mentioned by the Appellate Authority in the impugned order was not even a charge to which the petitioner institution was to reply; the Regional Committee has also not withdrawn the recognition on this ground; and the petitioner- institution was required to be given an opportunity to show cause before recognition was withdrawn on the grounds mentioned in the appellate order; set aside the appellate order with further direction to the appellate authority after giving an opportunity to the petitioner institution, pass a fresh order. This has to be done preferably within a period of six weeks from the date a certified copy is filed by the petitioner before the Vice-Chairman of the NCTE. The petitioner filed a certified copy of the Hon'ble Court Order on 26.04.2010 which was received in the Council on 30.04.2010.

AND WHEREAS after perusal of documents, memorandum of appeal, VT Report, affidavit and after considering oral arguments advanced during hearing, the Committee reached the conclusion that there was enough ground to accept the appeal and that it should be accepted. Accordingly, the appeal was accepted and NRC's order dated 06-01-10 was reversed with a direction to the NRC vide Council's order dated 23.08.2010 to restore recognition to the institution.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before the NRC in its 166th Meeting held on 9th September, 2010 and the committee decided to restore recognition to the institution.

NOW, THEREFORE, in compliance of order passed by the Appellate Authority and in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Northern Regional Committee hereby restore recognition granted to **Brahaspati Mahila Mahavidyalaya, 50, K Block, Kidwai Nagar, Kanpur-208011, Uttar Pradesh** for conducting **B.Ed Course of Secondary (Level) of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 (One hundred Only) students** vide order dated **03.07.2007**.

The other terms and conditions will remain same as mentioned in the recognition order dated 03.07.2007.


