

- After perusal of the memorandum of appeal, affidavit, documents available on records and considering the oral arguments advanced during the hearing, the Committee concluded that the appeal deserves to be remanded to the NRC with a direction to get all the four approvals verified by the University and take further action as per the NRC Regulations, 2014. In the meanwhile, the order of withdrawal shall be kept in abeyance.
- The Council hereby reverses the case of Shailesh Mahavidyalaya, Ghazipur, Uttar Pradesh to the NRC, NCTE, for necessary action as indicated above.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was considered by Emergent Meeting and 275th Meeting (Part-1) held on 16th to 18th and 19th to 21st September, 2017 and NRC decided as following: -


- “As per direction of the Appellate Authority dated 31.08.2017, it was decided to write to the registrar of Veer Bahadur Singh Purvanchal University, Jaunpur, Uttar Pradesh to examine the authenticity of the letters received from the Registrar, Veer Bahadur University, Jaunpur, UP in connection with the approval of appointment of teachers in B.Ed. department of Shailesh Mahavidyalaya, Ghazipur, Uttar Pradesh vide letters dated 22.06.2015, 26.06.2015, 18.09.2015 and 05.05.2016 respectively and to enclose copy of all the four communications of Veer Bahadur Singh Purvanchal University Meanwhile, Order of withdrawal dated 25.7.2017 be kept in abeyance.”

Accordingly, the letter to the Registrar of the University was sent for authentication of the letters on 22.09.2017.

AND WHEREAS, the University has submitted reply in NRC office vide letter dated 03.11.2017. The matter was considered by NRC in its 277th Meeting held on 05th to 06th December, 2017 and Committee decided that “the reply dated 03.11.2017 received from Veer Bahadur Singh Purvanchal University, Jaunpur in response to NRC letter dated 22.09.2017 was considered by NRC and NRC decided that recognition granted to the institution for B.Ed. course vide NRC order dated 01.03.2016 is hereby restored.”

Now therefore, the recognition of Shailesh Mahavidyalaya, Plot No. – 531, Village – Sawas, Post Office – Sadar, Tehsil/Taluka – Jakhania, District – Ghazipur, State - Uttar Pradesh for B.Ed. course with an annual intake of 50 students granted vide order no. File No./NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-4340/250th Meeting/2016/142231-51 dated 01.03.2016 is hereby restored.

ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to Shailesh Mahavidyalaya, Plot No. – 531, Village – Sawas, Post Office – Sadar, Tehsil/Taluka – Jakhania, District – Ghazipur, State - Uttar Pradesh for B.Ed. course vide order No. File No./NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-4340/250th Meeting/2016/142231-51 dated 01.03.2016 with an annual intake of 50 seats from the academic session 2016-2017.

AND WHEREAS, a letter dated 28.07.2016 was received from Veer Bahadur Singh Purvanchal University, Jaunpur, Uttar Pradesh. The matter was considered by NRC in its 256th Meeting held on 22nd to 25th August, 2016 and NRC decided to issue Show Cause Notice on the following grounds: -

The Committee considered the letter of the Vice Chancellor, Veer Bahadur Singh Purvanchal University, Jaunpur, Uttar Pradesh and decided that a Show Cause Notice be issued under Section-17 to the institution giving 30 days time for submission of reply from the date of Show Cause Notice on the following points: -

- As per letter no. पत्रांक-प.वि.वि./सम्ब./01-(जॉच)2016/8559 dt. 28.07.2016 received on 07.08.2016 from the Registrar, Veer Bahadur Singh Purvanchal University, Jaunpur, U.P., the Committee decided that show cause notice be issued to the institution under section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 before withdrawal of recognition of the institution on the ground that the list of faculty duly approved by the affiliating body and submitted by the institution in the office of NRC for getting recognition is fake.

AND WHEREAS, the institution on the basis of minutes uploaded on the website submitted reply of Show Cause Notice. The matter was considered by 261st Meeting held on 14th to 19th December, 2016 and the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition to the institution of the following grounds: -

- The institution was granted recognition under clause 7(16) vide Order 01.03.2016. After recognition, NRC received letter from the Registrar, Veer Bahadur Singh Purvanchal University, Jaunpur. In the letter, the Registrar mentioned that the institution has been given recognition on fake faculty list. Hence, institution was given show cause notice and reply submitted by the institution is not acceptable. The institution has tried to mislead NRC by submission of fake list.

Accordingly, the withdrawal order was issued on 25.07.2017.

AND WHEREAS, the above Institution thereafter preferred an appeal before the Council (New Delhi) under section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993. The Appellate Authority passed an order dated 31.08.2017 in the appeal. The operative part of appeal is as under:-

- The Committee noted from the file that the NRC did not seek verification of the authenticity of the University's letter dated 22.06.2015, 26.06.2015 and 18.09.2015 and the letter dated 05.05.2016 enclosed to the appellant letter dated 'Nil' faculty which is reported to have been approved by the University, the Committee concluded that the matter deserved to be remanded to the NRC with a direction to get all the approvals verified by the University and take further action as per the NRC Regulations, 2014. In the meanwhile, the order of withdrawal shall be kept in abeyance.
