ORDER

WHEREAS, in terms of Section 14/15 of the NCTE Act, 1993, Kundan Group Off Institueions, Plot No. 217, Village - Prasiddhapur, Post Office- Rania, Tehsil- Akbarpur, Dist.- Kanpur Dehat 9UP) 209304, had submitted an application to the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE forseeking recognition/permission to the institution namely, KLS College, Plot No. 217, Village - Prasiddhapur, Post Office- Rania, Tehsil- Akbarpur, Dist.- Kanpur Dehat 9 (UP) 209304 for D.El.Ed. Course of two years duration on 15.05.2015.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was considered by NRC in its 250th Meeting (Part-12) held from 19th February, to 3rd March, 2016 and the Committee decided that recognition be granted to the institution for D.El.Ed. course for one unit (50 students) under clause 7(16) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 from the academic session 2016-2017.

AND WHEREAS, the institution preferred an appeal before the Council and the appellate authority passed an order dated 24.11.2017. The operative part is as under:-


“AND WHEREAS, after perusal of the memorandum of appeal, affidavit, documents available on records and considering the oral arguments advanced during the hearing, the Committee concluded that the appeal deserves to be remanded to NRC Jaipur for reconsideration of the case in light of representations dated 05.04.2016, 06.06.2016 and 27.04.2017 submitted by the appellant. Appellant is required to submit copies of the above representation to N.R.C., Jaipur within 15 days of the issue of Appeal orders as the relevant regulatory file does not contain these representations. Reconsideration of the case shall further be subject to necessary verification of the documents already submitted by the appellant to N.R.C. Jaipur for seeking recognition. As per directions of the Hon'ble High Court of Allahabad, the case is required to be disposed of within 8 weeks from 19.09.2017 i.e. date of receiving certified copy of order dated 04.09.2017 in Writ Petition case no. 40347/2017.”

AND WHEREAS, the matter was considered by NRC in its 277th meeting held on 05th to 06th December, 2017 and the Committee decided as under:-

- In compliance of Order dated 24.11.2017 passed by the Appeal Committee, the Committee decided that recognition be granted to the institution for D.El.Ed. course for two units (100 students) under clause 7(16) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 from the academic session 2018-2019 in place of one unit (50 students) granted earlier.

NOW THEREFORE, the Northern, Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to the institution for D.El.Ed. course for 100 seats (Two units of 50 Students each) under clause 7(16) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 from the academic session 2018-2019 in place of (one unit of 50 students) granted earlier vide order no. File No. NRC/NCTE/Recognition/D.El.Ed./2016/142867-3467 dated 03.03.2016.
