ORDER

18 DEC 2017

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to S. G. R. Mahavidyalaya, VPO – Talgram, Tehsil – Chibramau, District – Kannauj, State - Uttar Pradesh for B.Ed. course vide order No. File No./NRC/NCTE/F-7/UP-3219/177th Meeting/2011/5028 dated 18.02.2011.

AND WHEREAS, a complaint was made by Shri Mahesh Chander Rajput, Village – Mayapurve, Post Office – Janpat, District – Kannauj, State - Uttar Pradesh. In his letter dated 16.02.2012 addressed to the Central Vigilance Commission, New Delhi, the complainant alleged that the institution submitted fake CLU and obtained recognition from NRC (No. 7-6/2013/NCTE/Vig.).

AND WHEREAS, the inspection u/s 13 was conducted by NCTE Hqs., New Delhi. The VTR was received from NCTE Hqs. on 30.01.2017 with direction to place the matter before NRC in its forth coming Meeting. The matter was considered by NRC in its 263rd (Part-6) Meeting and as per decision of NRC, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 21.02.2017 on the following grounds: -

- NRC granted recognition for B.Ed. vide its recognition order dated 18.02.2011.
- A complaint by Shri Mahesh Chandra Rajput dated 16.02.2012 was lodged with CVC, New Delhi claiming that the applicant institution submitted a fake CLU to get the recognition.
- NCTE Hqs. got the issue examined by the District Magistrate, Kannauj and found that the CLU bearing number 578 dated 02.06.2005 had not been issued by the concerned office.
- The building plan submitted by the institution does not bear the Khasra number of the land on which the building has been constructed. Moreover, the building plan is in three parts/pieces pasted with one another. This is not acceptable.
- BCC signed by the Competent Govt. authority has not been submitted with the VT report.
- An affidavit on Rs. 100/- has not been submitted as per the provision of the NCTE Regulations, 2014.

AND WHEREAS, the institution submitted reply in NRC Office on 21.03.2017. The matter was considered by NRC in its 266th (Part-4) Meeting held on 21st to 24th March, 2017 and the Committee decided that the recognition/permission granted to the institution is withdrawn on the following grounds: -

NRC considered the reply dated 20.03.2017 of the institution with regard to the SCN issued by the NRC on 21.02.2017 and the following observations were made:-

- The reply is not satisfactory and hence not acceptable. NRC decided to withdraw the recognition from the next academic session. A letter from the District Magistrate, Kannauj dated 28.09.2016 reveals that the CLU No. 578 dated 02.06.2005 submitted by the institution is fake. In compliance of the order of the NCTE Hqs. dated 16.02.2017, Copy of CLU No. 578 dated 02.06.2005 be obtained from NCTE HQ and thereafter FIR be lodged against the institution.



AND WHEREAS, the withdrawal order was issued on 13.04.2017.

AND WHEREAS, the Institution preferred appeal before the Council (New Delhi) under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993. The Appellate Authority passed an order dated 16.10.2017. The operative part of order is as under:-

- There is no doubt that there was a misconduct on part of the appellant institution, but it is still felt that the disputed document was not made use of for grant of recognition and appellant has apologised for the lapse on its part. The institution was recognised for conducting B.Ed. programme in February, 2011 and the penalty to withdraw recognition by issue of impugned refusal order 13.04.2017 is not proportionate to the admitted misconduct moreso when the alleged document was not made use of for granting recognition.
- Appeal Committee, therefore, decided to reverse the impugned withdrawal order dated 13.04.2017.
- After perusal of the memorandum of appeal, affidavit, documents available on records oral arguments advanced during the hearing, Appeal Committee concluded to reverse the impugned refusal order dated 13.04.2017.
- The Council hereby reverses the case of S. G. R. Mahavidyalaya, Yaduvansh Nagar, Talgram, Talgram Road, Talgram – 209731, Uttar Pradesh to the NRC, NCTE, for necessary action as indicated above.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was considered by NRC in its 277th Meeting held on 05th to 06th December, 2017 and the Committee decided that “in compliance of the order dated 16.10.2017 of the Appeal Committee, the recognition granted to institution vide NRC Order dated 18.2.2011 for running B.Ed. course for 100 students is hereby restored.”

Now therefore, the recognition of S. G. R. Mahavidyalaya, VPO – Talgram, Tehsil – Chibramau, District – Kannauj, State - Uttar Pradesh for B.Ed. course granted vide order no. File No./NRC/NCTE/F-7/UP-3219/177th Meeting/2011/5028 dated 18.02.2011 is hereby restored.
