The National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) is a statutory body that came into existence in pursuance of the National Council for Teacher Education Act, 1993 (No. 73 of 1993) on 17th August 1995 to achieve planned and coordinated development of the teacher education system throughout the country, the regulation and proper maintenance of norms and standards in the teacher education system and for matters connected therewith.

- 2. In accordance with para 1.8 of the National Council for Teacher Education (Recognition, Norms and Procedure) Amendment Regulations 2021 notified in the Gazette of India on 26.10.2021 for norms and standards with respect to Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP), the General Body of the Council in its 60th (Emergent) meeting held on 14th March 2024 decided to invite online applications for the 4th phase of ITEP. These applications will be from multidisciplinary institutions for the academic session 2025-2026 u/s 14 and 15 of the NCTE Act 1993 based upon the Shortlisting Criteria prescribed by the General Body.
