CM APPL. 1435/2021 (seeking correction)

1. The petitioners seek correction of a typographical error in the order dated 07.01.2021, by which the writ petition was disposed of.

2. In paragraph 5(b) of the said order, the academic year is mentioned as "2021-2022", whereas Mr. Amitesh Kumar, learned counsel for the petitioners, submits that it should have read as "2020-2021". Mr. Jaideep Khanna, learned counsel for the respondents, does not dispute this position.

3. In view of the above, paragraph 5(b) of the order dated 07.01.2021 is corrected and will read as follows:

- "b) Until such a decision is taken, the petitioner is entitled to all consequential reliefs including reinstatement as a recognised institution and to participate in the admission process for the academic year 2020-21 and subsequent years."
- 4. The application is disposed of in the above terms.
