State of Chhattisgarh. <b>The University cannot open its centres even within the state as per the provision of UGC (Establishment of and Maintenance of Standards in Private Universities) Regulations, 2003 without the approval of UGC.</b> The UGC has not granted any approval to the University to open off campus/study centre. The University cannot offer its programme through franchising arrangement with Private coaching institutions even for the purpose of conducting of courses through distance mode.</p> <p>The Diploma / certificate courses are not specified by UGC. However, universities can run the diploma / certificate course with due approval of its Governing councils / Statutory council wherever required.</p> <p><b>The Private Universities are unitary in nature and cannot affiliate any college.</b></p> <p>The degree(s)/diploma(s)/certificate(s) are verified /validated by the issuing authority i.e.</p>


