- (i) By reviewing the total space available in the institution's building, the space allotted for B.Ed.-2 units, M.Ed.-1 unit, D.El.Ed.-1 unit and B.Sc.B.Ed. 2 units, it is observed as mentioned in the Building Plan, the institution has Block B measuring 1033.44 sq.mtrs. extra which is not in accordance with NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time. The institution is required to clarify the same.
- (ii) With regard to affiliation order related to running of multi-disciplinary programmes, the university has replied that "Banasthali Vidyapeeth is a deemed university recognized by UGC and re-evaluated with A++ grade by NAAC. The Bachelor of Science, Bachelor of Technology, Master of Pharmacy, Master of Arts, Master of Philosophy, Master of Science, Master of Technology, Bachelor of Arts Bachelor of Legislative Law, Bachelor of Business Administration & Bachelor of Legislative Law, Bachelor of Arts, LLM, Bachelor of Business Administration, Bachelor of Commerce-Bachelor of Legislative Law, Bachelor of Pharmacy, Master of Business Administration, Master of Design, Bachelor of Pharmacy, Master of Business Administration, Master of Computer Applications, Master of Commerce, Master of Design and Master of Social Work programs have been approved by the Academic Council and other Technical Departments for the year 2024-25 uploaded. The institution is required to clarify the rational how the institution has been offering multiple programmes of different disciplines.

The online application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time along with reply of Show Cause Notice and the Committee observed as under:

- (i) The institution is required to upload the recommendation of the State Government / UT Administration.
- (ii) The institution has uploaded IT Form-10AC in respect of Not-for-Profit Certificate & Exemption Certificate (12A). The institution is required to upload Not-for-Profit Certificate issued by Competent Government Authority.
- (iii) The institution is required to upload Certificate of Registration of the Society / Trust; Bye-laws etc. issued by Competent Government Authority.
- (iv) It cannot be ascertained from the documents uploaded by the institution that it falls in the category of multi-disciplinary institutions as per the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time. The institution is required to upload latest affiliation orders issued by the affiliating university in respect of the courses of liberal arts, humanities, social science etc. being run in the same premises.
- (v) The name of the applicant institution is "K.R.T. ARTS, B.H. COMMERCE AND A.M. SCIENCE (K.T.H.M.) COLLEGE" as mentioned in the online application portal that does not match with the name of institution mentioned in orders for B.Ed. and M.Ed. courses issued by NCTE i.e. "MARATHA VIDYA PRASARAK SAMAJ'S ADV. VITTHALRAO GANPATRAO HANDE COLLEGE OF EDUCATION" uploaded by the institution.
- (vi) The uploaded list of students admitted is without the name of the applicant institution and without countersignature of the competent authority of the affiliating university. The institution is required to upload current details of Admitted Students for different courses approved by its affiliating body.
- (vii) The institution is required to upload English version of the certified registered land documents issued by the Competent Government Authority.
- (viii) The institution is required to upload affidavit on Rs.100/- non-judicial stamp paper mentioning the total land area and total built-up area with Khasra Nos. etc.
- (ix) The institution is required to upload English version of Mutation Certificate indicating all the Khasra/Plot/Survey Nos. issued by Competent Authority of State Government specifically mentioning the Khasra No. where the institution has proposed to conduct the ITEP programme.

Decision of WRC:

The online application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time along with reply of Show Cause Notice and the Committee observed as under:

- (i) The institution has uploaded CA Certificate. However, the institution has not uploaded Not for Profit Certificate issued by Competent Government Authority. The institution is required to upload Not-for-Profit Certificate issued by Competent Government Authority.
- (ii) As per the land documents uploaded by the institution, it is observed that the total land area Khasra No. 492/1 is 2,800 sq.mtr. whereas total built-up area is observed in the same Khasra No. is 1903 sq.mtr. Moreover, the institution has been conducting degree courses i.e. B.A., B.Sc. (Computer Science, Physics, Chemistry, Biology & Mathematics), BCA, B.Com., BBA M.Com., M.Sc., PGDCA, PG in Yoga. The sufficiency of land and built-up area for 1903 sq.mtr. and 100 intake for B.Ed. and 50 intake for B.P.Ed. course cannot be ascertained. The institution is required to upload Building Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government indicating the Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the total land and built-up area earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land and built-up area for the teacher education programmes including multi-disciplinary programmes.
- (iii) The institution has uploaded Deed Endorsement (Deed type -35-Lease) in respect of khasra no. 492/1 Land Area 740.0000 sq.mtr. approved by Manish Bhandarkar Notary/ Advocate Raipur (C.G.) India. The institution has uploaded Land Documents in respect of khasra no.42/13 Area 0.405 Hectare approved by Manish Bhandarkar Notary/ Advocate Raipur (C.G.) India. However, only Khasra Number 492/1 has been

- mentioned in the online application whose total land area is only 2800 sq.mt. and also 740 sq.mt. has been shown in the lease deed.
- (iv) The institution is required to upload Change of Land Use Certificate (CLU) in respect of khasra no. 492/1 issued by Competent Government Authority.
- (v) The institution has uploaded Building Completion Certificate (BCC) vide letter dated 14.02.2025 in respect of khasra no. 492/1 area 0.354 Hectare approved by Sanyukt Sanchalak, Nagar tatha Gram Nivesh, Kshetriya Karyalaya Raipur Chhattisgarh. However, the institution has not uploaded the BCC having 17 points format prescribed by NCTE. The institution is required to upload latest Building Completion Certificate in the prescribed format of NCTE (17 points) issued by the Competent Government Authority for all the courses being conducted in the premises
- (vi) The institution has uploaded Building plan showing Multipurpose Hall in respect of Khasra no.492/1 (in 164.9029 sq m and 127.67 sq.mt.). But the Multipurpose Hall is at two different locations and Location highlighted in Building Plan uploaded is not readable. The institution is required to upload legible Building Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government indicating the Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the total land and built-up area earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land and built-up area for the teacher education programmes including multi-disciplinary programmes.
- (vii) The institution has uploaded Building Safety Certificate issued by Nagar Sena Agnishaman Evam Apatkalin sevaye tha Rajya Apadaye Mochan Bal Mukhyalaya Sector 19 Atal Nagar Nava Raipur Jila Raipur, Chhattisgarh without mentioning year/time period therein. The institution is required to upload Building Safety Certificate in adherence of safety guidelines as prescribed by National/State Disaster Management Authority issued by Competent Government Authority.

Decision of WRC:

The online application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

The institution had not uploaded the reply of Final Show Cause Notice dated 21.04.2025 within the stipulated time.

The institution is deficient on the following grounds of final Show Cause Notice:

- (i) The University has not uploaded Affidavit on Rs. 100/- Non-Judicial stamp paper in prescribed format regarding land documents.
- (ii) The University has not uploaded Mutation Certificate (Jamabandi-Khasra-Khatoni) in respect of Khasra/ Survey no. 449p1,449p2/p1,449p4, 451p1/p2, 451p2,448 p1 issued by Revenue Department.
- (iii) The University has not uploaded Non Encumbrance Certificate in respect of Khasra/

- Survey No. 449p1,449p2/p1, 449p4, 451p1/p2, 451p2,448 p1 issued by Revenue Department and it has not been issued by Tehsildar.
- (iv) Details of uploaded building plan by the university concerned are not mentioned in the reply which is required for examination and cross verification from the uploaded Building Plan since uploaded Building Plan is illegible. The institution has not uploaded legible Building Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government indicating the Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the total land area and built-up area earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land are and built up area for the teacher education programmes.
- (v) The University has not uploaded Building Safety Certificate in adherence of safety guidelines as prescribed by National/State Disaster Management Authority.
- (vi) Built-up area of the university buildings in the uploaded Building Completion Certificate is not mentioned.

In view of the above, the application for ITEP is rejected.

Decision of WRC:

The online application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

The institution had not uploaded the reply of Show Cause Notice dated 06.02.2024 and the reply of Final Show Cause Notice dated 21.04.2025 within the stipulated time.

The institution is deficient on the following grounds of final Show Cause Notice:

- (i) The institution had not uploaded the reply of First Show Cause Notice dated 06.02.2025.
- (ii) Name of the institution mentioned in the applied ITEP application mismatch with the name of institution mentioned in uploaded NAAC accreditation Grade "A" certificate. The institution has uploaded photocopy of authorization letter on Rs.100/- Non-judicial stamp paper and details mentioned in the particulars with the details in the uploaded Non-judicial stamp paper.
- (iii) The institution has not uploaded Not-for-profit certificate issued by the Govt. Competent Authority.
- (iv) Uploaded details of Society/Trust are incomplete.
- (v) Name of the institution mentioned in the applied ITEP application mismatch with the name mentioned in letter uploaded for Multi-disciplinary programme issued by the concerned affiliating body/university. Documents pertaining to change of name of the institution has not uploaded for confirmation of name applied for ITEP application. Uploaded letter is in regional language (Marathi) which is required also in notarized translated English version for appropriate examination.
- (vi) Name of the institution mentioned in the applied ITEP application is totally mismatch with the name mentioned in the uploaded recognition order issued by NCTE.

- (vii) The institution has not uploaded affidavit on Rs.100/- Non-Judicial stamp paper and uploaded land documents is in the regional language (Marathi) for which it could not be examined appropriately without translated English version of the document.
- (viii) The institution has not uploaded Mutation Certificate of land issued by the Govt. Competent Authority.
- (ix) Land Use Certificate (CLU) is not uploaded.
- (x) Current Non-Encumbrance Certificate is not uploaded.
- (xi) Uploaded Building plan is not approved by the competent govt. engineer.
- (xii) The institution has not uploaded Building Completion Certificate issued by the Competent Govt. Authority in the prescribed format of NCTE.
- (xiii) The institution has uploaded affidavit but details mentioned in particulars of the applied application differ with the uploaded affidavit.

In view of the above, the application for ITEP is rejected.

Decision of WRC:

The online application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time along with reply of Final Show Cause Notice dated 31.01.2025 and the Committee observed as under:

- (i) The name of the institution "Bhartiya Balika Shikshan Prashikshan Mahavidyalaya" mentioned in the application and recognition order of B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. whereas "Bhartiya Mahila P.G. Mahavidyalaya" mentioned in the university letter of affiliation with regard to Multi-disciplinary Programmes uploaded by the institution. Both the names are different. Therefore, as per NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time, the application of the institution does not fall in the category of Multi-disciplinary institution.
- (ii) The institution is conducting degree courses i.e. B.A. with 660 intake, B.Sc. with 300 intake, M.A. (Geography, English, Pol. Science) with 160 intake, M.Sc. (Maths, Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology,) with 200 intake combined intake of 1320. The sufficiency of land and built-up area for 1320 intake of multidisciplinary courses and 100 intake for B.A.B.Ed. / B.Sc. B.Ed. course and 200 intake for B.Ed. course cannot be ascertained.
- (iii) The institution has not uploaded Not-for-Profit Certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority.
- (iv) In the land documents uploaded by the institution, Khasra Nos. 208/164 with land area 1.11 hectare is mentioned, whereas in the online application, Khasra Nos. 303/164 and 306/164 are mentioned. In the Mutation Certificate uploaded by the institution, Khasra Nos. 193/115, 294/114, 295/114, 401/193, 303/164 etc. are mentioned. In the CLU/Samparivartan Aadesh uploaded by the institution, only Khasra No.303/164 with

- 4,000 sq.mtr. land area is mentioned. Therefore, the Khasra Nos. do not match in all the land documents uploaded by the institution.
- (v) The institution has uploaded Building Plan without approval of the Competent Authority of State Government and the uploaded Building Plan has not indicated the Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the total land area and built-up area earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land and built-up area for the teacher education programmes including multi-disciplinary programmes. The total land area mentioned in the Building Plan is 11,100 sq.mtr. and total built-up area is mentioned 4,500 sq.mtr. whereas in the BCC uploaded by the institution, the total land area mentioned is 4,000 sq.mtr. and total built-up area mentioned is 4,500 sq.mtr. There is mismatch in the total land area in uploaded Building Plan and BCC and Khasra No. is not mentioned in the uploaded BCC.
- (vi) The institution has not uploaded list/details of students admitted in the 4 year Integrated B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. course year-wise for the academic session 2023-2024 duly countersigned by Registrar of concerned affiliating University.
- (vii) The institution has uploaded old list of teaching staff duly approved and countersigned by its affiliating body and uploaded list of teaching staff is not in the prescribed format of NCTE.
- (viii) The institution has uploaded bank statement indicating the transaction of the salary / remuneration to its teaching staff. However, it cannot be ascertained from the uploaded documents whether the institution is paying salary to its staff as per Central/State Government pay scales in accordance with the norms and standards of NCTE.
- (ix) The website of institution has NOT been updated and maintained in compliance to provisions under Clause 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.

Decision of WRC:

The online application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time along with Visiting Team Report dated 06.05.2025 and the Committee observed as under:

The institution is deficient on the following grounds on the observations made by the Visiting Team:

- (i) The building of the institution has 2-3 floors. Upper floors can be accessed only by stairs, without any provision of ramp or lift, No Persons with Disability (PwD) friendly toilet could be seen. Barrier free environment needs urgent improvements as the building having 3 floors does not have ramps/lifts for vertical mobility. PwD toilets were not shown to the team.
- (ii) Furniture and Fixture:
 - a) Physics lab, Yoga room, Medical room, seminar hall need improvements in terms of furniture and equipment.

- b) The Multipurpose Hall has inadequate furniture and Seating Capacity. It requires to be upgraded.
- c) The furniture of Art room in Activity Cum Resource Center requires to be upgraded.
- d) The language lab is not available separately.
- e) The furniture of Medical room of Health and Physical Education Centre requires to be upgraded.
- f) Common Room appropriate furniture required.
- g) The furniture of the institution is very less and mostly of plastic. Furniture is very old and outdated, so the institution is required to be procured new furniture.

(iii) Laboratories:

- a) The size of Science Stream Laboratories is very small and the equipment and apparatus is inadequate.
- b) The psychology lab is also required improvement.
- c) The language lab is required to be established accordingly. The institution is required to create separate language lab.
- d) Yoga room is very small and without any facilities and equipment.
- e) The VT has reported that institute need to improve laboratories, as they could not show their publications. Laboratories are inadequately furnished and equipped. The common room, medical room, art room were not furnished properly.

(iv) Library:

- a) The institution is required to add more volumes and journal.
- b) The Seating Capacity of the library is inadequate, reading area has plastic chairs, which required to be replaced by comfortable ones.
- c) The institution is required to add more titles of book.
- d) The Professional Research General is not presented to inspection team.
- e) The institution has inadequate facilities such as LIBRARY, books and toilet facilities which are not up to the mark.
- f) The institute need to improve library, as they could not show their publications.
- g) Education Encyclopedia not shown to inspection team.
- h) Electronic Publication not shown to inspection team.
- i) Digital or Online Resources not shown to inspection team.

(v) Infrastructure Facilities:

- a) Availability of developed Kitchen Garden Not available
- b) Rain Water Harvesting System not shown to inspection team.
- c) Art and craft room needs to improve.
- (vi) All payments to faculty are not digital, most of the procurement proofs were inadequate, without any payment proofs.
- (vii) The institution is required to upload Building Safety Certificate in adherence of safety guidelines as prescribed by National/State Disaster Management Authority issued by Competent Government Authority.
- (viii) The institution is required to upload Fire Safety Certificate issued by Fire Safety Department, Government of Rajasthan verifiable on the official portal of the Fire Department, Government of Rajasthan at URL https://lsgonline.rajasthan.gov.in/track_application.aspx

The sufficiency of land and built-up area for 2440 intake of multidisciplinary courses and 250 intake of proposed ITEP cannot be ascertained.
- (ii) The institution has not uploaded Building Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government indicating the Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the total land area and built-up area earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land area and built-up area for the teacher education programmes including multi-disciplinary programmes.
- (iii) The institution has not uploaded No Objection Certificate from the Competent Authority of Ministry of Defence for introducing new course of Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) notified by NCTE vide Gazette Notification No.509 dated 26.10.2021 on the analogy of the Ministry of Defence order no. 10/27/L/L&C/59-L/1614-L/D(C&L) dated 25.03.1960 and Order No. ULC/DLC/Sophia College/Ajmer/Sec.19/79/1817/D(Lands) dated 26.03.1980 .
- (iv) The Building Completion Certificate uploaded by the institution is not approved by the Competent Government Authority.

In view of the above, the application for ITEP is rejected.

- (vi) Land alloted by Jaipur Development Authority to the University uploaded but not certified by the competent authority in respect of khasra no. 410, 497,500.
- (vii) Mutation Certificate of land uploaded is not legible.
- (viii) the University has uploaded Land Use Certificate but not proper readable.
- (ix) The University has uploaded Building plan but not approved by Govt. Competent Authority. The University is required to upload Building plan approved by Govt. Competent Authority mentioning name of University, Khasra no./Plot no., total land area, total floor wise built-up area, and earmarked land and built up area for each course being run in same premises.
- (x) The University has not uploaded Building Safety Certificate National/State Disaster Management Authority.
- (xi) The University has not uploaded Fire Safety Certificate issued by Govt. Competent Authority.
- (xii) Seal of the certifying government authority not stamped in the Building Completion Certificate.
