Smt. Mala Shrivastava, Chairperson, WRC, Shri Chandrashekhar Vazalwar, Shri Anil Bedge, Prof. Freny Tarapore, Members, expressed their inability to attend the meeting. The Representatives of States/UTs of Chhattisgarh, Daman & Diu and Dadra & Nagar Haveli could not attend the meeting.

At the outset, Shri Satish Gupta, Regional Director and Convener, welcomed the Chairperson and all the members of WRC, NCTE to 238th meeting of the WRC.

The Regional Director, being Convener of the WRC, presented each agenda item for consideration of the WRC.

The agenda were taken up as follows:-

238.1 Confirmation of the minutes of 237th Meeting of WRC.

The Committee confirmed the minutes of the 237th meeting of WRC held on December 21-22, 2015.

238.2 Action Taken Report on the minutes of the 237th Meeting of WRC.

Regional Director informed that required action is being taken on the minutes of the 237th meeting. Action taken report will be submitted in the next meeting.

238.3 Policy Decisions/letters received from NCTE Hqrs./State Govt.

The Regional director presented before the WRC Letter No. B.Ed.- 4615/C.R.203/Mashi-2 dated 29.12.2015 from the Govt. of Maharashtra. According to the letter, the State Govt. had intimated to NCTE vide its letter dated 20.03.2015 for not granting recognition to B.Ed./M.Ed. courses in the State for the year 2016-17 with exception to minority institutions. This letter was with reference to the public notice issued by the NCTE on 27.02.2015.

The Committee decided that Regional Director will write the letter to the NCTE Hqrs. to find out if any action has been taken on the letter dated 20.03.2015 addressed to the NCTE.

The State Govt., in its letter dated 29.12.2015, has decided to scrutinize the proposals of composite institutions and send the recommendation within 45 days. The Committee considered the matter and decided that the cases should be processed if mandatory period of 90 days for receiving the State Govt. recommendation is over.

The institute has submitted registered lease document of the year 2012; it means the institute has acquired land & building on lease to run the institute in the year 2012. The background of the case is as follows:-
				The society applied for B.Ed. course in the year 2003. At that time NCTE Regulations 2002 was in force. According to the Regulations, a Society was eligible to start Teacher Education Course in a rental premise if it has land on its own name.
				At the time of its application, the Society had not the land in its name. The Society purchased the land measuring 0.418 Acre in the year 2004. The building was on rental basis and it was on lease from Ram Sevak Singh.
			Ĺ	As per Regulations 2002, the institute was allowed to run in rental building if the Society has land in its own name. As per the Regulations the society will build its own building within 3 years and shift institute from the rental building.
				On perusal of the records submitted by the institute alongwith its reply dated 21.05.2015 it has been found that the Society has acquired land in the same village with survey no. 353, 377, 351, 355 on 30 years private lease. The registered documents includes the building on survey no. 353, that was taken on rental basis in the year 2003.

				Thus, the institute is still running on a rental premises. The Society has land in its own name that was purchased in the year 2004 and it did not build its own building in the land and continued to run the institution in rental premises. Whereas, as per Regulations 2002, the Society was to construct the building and shift to its premises between 3 years of the grant of Recognition. As is clear from the above facts, the Society is running the institute in violation of the NCTE Regulations.
				The institute was also asked to introduce the benefit of CPF for the staff. In reply, the institute has submitted that the CPF amount is being deducted from the salary of the staff but it has not submitted any proof in this regard.
				Hence, Show Cause Notice u/s 17 be issued on the above grounds.

On perusal of the documents, it has been found that the documents relating to building with constructed area 1832.1 sq.mt. relates to B.Ed. course. The document submitted for another block measuring 2956.71 sq. mt. is only the photocopy of the Building Plan which is not notarized and there are overwriting on the size of the built-up area. Thus, this document cannot be accepted. The institute has also not submitted Building Completion Certificate.
				As regards to point no. 2 that relates to allowing the benefits of CPF and annual increments, the institute has submitted that it is already paying revised pay scales and employees of the society are covered by the CPF. The institute has submitted the EPF code Registration No. alongwith the reply and bank account statements of the employees but it has not submitted any proof that substantiates that the society has separate EPF numbers of the employees.

It has appointed a retired professor on contract basis and intimated that the process of filling the post is on. The institution was also advised to improve service conditions of the staff by introducing new pay scales & other benefits like CPF. In its reply, the institution has submitted that it is providing the services like EPF, health insurance to the staff but no proof regarding the extension of the services and payment of approved pay scales to the employees has been submitted.
