### (1) CONSIDERATION OF THE CASES OF THE INSTITUTIONS WHICH HAVE NOT SUBMITTED PAR FOR THE ACADEMIC SESSION 2022-2023.

The Committee noted that under Section 12 (k) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the following is mandated as one of the functions of the Council:

*(k) evolve suitable performance appraisal system, norms and mechanism for enforcing accountability on recognised institutions;"*

2. In view of the above provision, the General Body of NCTE in its **61<sup>st</sup> Meeting** held on **05.08.2024** deliberated on the agenda in detail and approved the following:

- I. "Online PAR Module which is to be filed by the recognised institutions.
- II. Replica of the Online PAR Module
- III. General Instructions for filling up the PAR
- IV. Public Notice for the recognised institutions to submit PAR for the Academic Session(s) 2021-22 & 2022-23
- V. Format of certificate to be obtained from the affiliating body by the institution concerned that the institution is affiliated to it and is following all the Norms and Standards of NCTE for Programme Recognized by NCTE.
  - a. ....Apart from the above, the Council Authorized the Chairperson, NCTE to decide the timeline for submission of PAR by the recognized TEIs and for any further alteration and deletion in the Online PAR Module as per requirement for the aforesaid and subsequent academic session(s)"

3. In pursuance of the decision taken by the Council in the 61<sup>st</sup> **General Body Meeting** held on **05.08.2024**, a Public Notice dated 09.09.2024 was issued that required all the recognized Teacher Education Institutions (TEIs) to submit Performance Appraisal Report (PAR) for academic session(s) 2021-22 and 2022-23 on the online NCTE portal. The deadline to submit PAR was 10.11.2024 and the same was further extended to 10.12.2024 and subsequently to 31.12.2024 vide public notice dated 7.11.2024 and 10.12.2024 respectively.

4. In addition to the public notices, multiple attempts through press releases, regular reminders and video messages of both the Chairperson and Member Secretary of NCTE, uploaded across all major social media platforms with complete guide/ tutorial for filling PAR were made to spread awareness and sensitize all the recognized teacher education institutions to for timely submission of their PAR.

5. The aforesaid matter was considered by the WRC in its 416<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 20<sup>th</sup> March 2025 and accordingly, Show Cause Notice(s) were issued to the TEIs which have not submitted the Performance Appraisal Report (PAR) for academic session 2022-23 through mail by the online module developed by the NCTE (HQ) for this purpose, to reply within 15 days. The said SCNs were sent to the TEIs through Speed Post as well.

6. The WRC noted the following:-

- (i) The Regional Director, WRC, NCTE in its 416<sup>th</sup> meeting held on March 20, 2025 apprised the Committee members about the status of the institutions which have submitted / not submitted PAR on the on-line portal.

- (ii) Committee considered the non-filler TEIs of PARs and decided to issue show cause notices under Section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 recognised Teacher Education Institutions (TEIs) who failed to submit duly filled in PAR through online mode for the academic session 2022-2023 giving 15 days time to submit the reply failing which appropriate action will be taken as deemed fit as per the provisions contained in the NCTE Act and Regulations.
- (iii) Accordingly, as per decision, the show cause notices under Section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 issued to the PAR non-filler TEIs.


On careful consideration of the reply/non-submission of reply to the show cause notice(s) of the Teacher Education institutions, NCTE Act 1993, Rules and Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, the WRC decided that the recognition granted to the institutions for the Programme(s) mentioned against each institution be withdrawn u/s 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 from the academic session 2025-26.

The institutions are not permitted to make further admissions in the above Teacher Education Programme henceforth w.e.f. 2025-2026.

The WRC further decided that before issue of Withdrawal order, the Regional Director may re-verify that the institutions have not submitted the reply to the Show Cause Notice.

## (2) Consideration cancellation of withdrawal order (PAR matter):
