contention is that the 3 Assistant Professors for
Performing Arts/ Fine Arts/ Physical Education
appointed for the basic B.Ed. programme will be
utilized to cover the requirements under B.A
B.Ed. and B.Sc. B.Ed. also.
5.2 The SRC is not able to accept this
contention. In any year, the minimum load per
Assistant Professor, under the (flexible)
arrangement proposed by the College, will be
600 students. It will not be realistic to expect an Assistant Professor to take charge of such a
work load.
work load.
5.3.1 It will be more appropriate if the
college appoints 3 Assistant Professors for
Performing Arts, Fine Arts, Physical
Education separately and exclusively for the
BA B.Ed. and B.Sc. B.Ed. courses.
5.3.2 We realize, it will take time to
complete action relating to creation of posts,
allocation of budget provisions, recruitments
of candidates, etc. The college must, however,
ensure that all this is done before they seek further extension of the recognition beyond
2018-19
5.4 The gap of 2 Assistant Professors in the
Perspective Group in any case has to be filled
irrespective of other considerations.
5.5 In this context, we wish also to alert
