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The SRC taken up the issue related to Language Pandit Programme, the discussion and decisions are as under:

- 1. The NCTE Regulations earlier covered language Pandit Programmes also to be regulated by the Regional Committees. These programmes, however, were removed from the recognized list in the 2014 Regulations of the NCTE.
- 2. The SRC took the stand that, consequent upon this development, the language Pandit Programmes went out of the purview of Regulation; and, the SRC had no *locus standi* to regulate them. In pursuance of this stand, the SRC decided to stop exercising any jurisdiction over these programmes since they had gone out of the NCTE's regulatory fold.
- 3. The SRC was of the view that, consequent upon the Notification of the 2014 Regulations, the recognition given by the SRC to these programmes will be deemed to have been withdrawn. But, the NCTE (HQ) informed that they were formulating new norms and standards; and, that no derecognition order may be issued.
- 4. There has been no further advice regarding such new norms and standards. Also, it has to be recognized that the Regulations would have to be amended even to enforce the new norms and standards. It is relevant here to note that the Hon'ble Supreme Court had categorically directed that, after Notification of the 2014 Regulations, no programme or Institution shall be recognized under any other Regulations.
- 5. In the meanwhile, at the ground level problems started cropping up because of confusion relating to affiliation by affiliating bodies. This has given rise to avoidable litigation by affected institutions.
- 6. This problem has assumed serious proportions in Telengana where the affiliating body (and, even the State Government) are being warned of contempt proceedings by the Hon'ble High Court.
- 7. In this emergent situation, it is clarified that the language Pandit Programmes are not being regulated by the SRC under the NCTE Regulations 2014. This should imply that regulation of these programmes will be deemed to have reverted to the affiliating bodies as hithertofore. In other words, absence of any recognition order by the SRC (of NCTE) need not be an impediment for affiliation or other control by the affiliating bodies.
- 8. In case the NCTE formulates new norms and standards and its Regulations are so amended, obviously, these programmes will revert to be old NCTE Regulatory fold.

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The SRC taken up the issue related to shifting of a Govt. Institution, the discussion and decisions are as under:

- 1. The State Government of Telengana have requested for urgent attention to permitting shifting of one of their B.Ed. Colleges, a Government C.T.E.
- 2. The college in reference is located in a dilapidated building near the Nagarjuna Sagar Dam site. Besides the danger of collapse of the dilapidated building, there can also be some concern about inundation. The offshoot of these concerns has been an alarming drop in the enrolment position rendering the college a hopelessly unviable proposition.
- 3. The proposal is to shift the college from the present location to the DIET premises at Nalgonda Town.
 - 3.1 The said premises admeasuring 7 acres of land belongs to the State Government. Sufficient land area is available to accommodate the shifting of this CTE and others.
 - 3.2.1. The State Government has reportedly approved construction of a new building for the CTE at the DIET site.
 - 3.2.2 The State Government has reportedly also sanctioned a budget provision of Rs.3.00 crores for the project.
- 4. Without waiting for all that to happen, however, the State Govt. proposes to shift the CTE to the DIET premises utilizing the vacant built up area available. They claim that additional area has also become available due to a Kendriya Vidyalaya, that was till recently functioning from these, shifting to its own premises.
- 5. The immediate benefit of this interim arrangement will be a good pick-up in the enrolment position as also better prospects for recruitment of teachers.
- 6. The State Govt. has assured that the CTE, even at the Nagarjuna Sagar site, is fulfilling all the prescribed norms and standards. It will continue to maintain them at the new site.
- 7. As regards faculty, they have emphasized a legal issue. Because of some long-standing legal issues dating back to 1998, they have still not been able to finalise the Graduation lists and form up the Recruitment Rules. That being so, the faculty list may not be made up of teachers recruited formally by the Recruitment Commission. Nevertheless, there will all the

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teachers recruited under the special arrangement put in place by the State Govt. for all teacher education institutions.

- 8. In appreciation of the special circumstances reported by the State Govt., the SRC has decided to accept their request and order a Visiting Team Inspection for the interim shift proposed.
- 9. Please initiate action accordingly and put up for further consideration when the VT Report is received.
