The Jamabandi and sheet mentioning the details of Mutation of Land Area of Guru Nanak Khalsa College which is not signed / approved by the Competent Government Authority. It is also observed that the plot no. mentioned in the application form does not tally with the Jamabandi uploaded by the institution. • Certificate to the effect that the building is differently abled friendly issued by the Architect and not from the Competent Government Authority. • Building Completion Certificate uploaded is issued by Municipal Corporation, however, the same is not in the prescribed format. <p>Hence, the Committee decided that Final Show Cause Notice be issued to the institution to submit reply on the deficiencies mentioned above within 15 days from the date of issue of Final Show Cause Notice.</p>

The uploaded document is a certificate given by the Private Architect which is not permissible as per NCTE Regulations 2014. • Building Completion/Permission Certificate/ permission for occupancy is issued by Senior Town Planner uploaded. However, the Building Completion Certificate is not in the prescribed format. • Building Safety Certificate uploaded is certified by the Private Architect and Chartered Engineer and not by the Competent Government Authority. • The validity period of the Fire Safety Certificate has lapsed. The institution is required to upload the renewed Fire Safety Certificate. • Certificate to the effect that the building is differently abled friendly issued by the Competent Government Authority is not uploaded. The certificate is issued by the Private Architect which is not permissible as per NCTE Regulations 2014. • The institution is required to upload a legible copy of permission for the land use issued by the Competent Government Authority. The uploaded certificate is not legible. • Blueprint of the building plan is not uploaded rather the institution has uploaded the photocopy of the building plan. The name of the proposed course, Khasra No./Plot No., total land area, Multi-purpose Hall, Library-cum-Reading room and earmarked area for the proposed ITEP are not shown in the building plan. • Site Plan is uploaded by the institution, however, the Plot No. and Survey No. mentioned in the land documents are not shown in the site plan. • The institution is required to upload the mutation certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority. The uploaded document is the possession certificate issued by Administrator, Faridabad Complex Admn. • The institution has not provided the details regarding payment of processing fees. The institution has mentioned in the application that it is a Government-Aided institution, the institution is required to clarify whether the proposed ITEP will be run on Self-Finance basis or otherwise. <p>Hence, the Committee decided that Final Show Cause Notice be issued to the institution to submit reply on the deficiencies mentioned above within 15 days from the date of issue of Final Show Cause Notice.</p>

The institution has never been granted recognition for B.A. B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. course. However, the institution has submitted an application for transition from the 4-year Integrated B.A. B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. course to Integrated Teacher Education programme (ITEP). 		<p>The Committee considered the reply for the final SCN submitted by the institution and noted the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> NCTE has already referred to the matter of the institution to the Ministry of Education to amend the NCTE Amendment Act, 2019 appropriately, so as to cover all the remaining cases of Central / State institutions which are at present running Teacher Education courses without recognition from NCTE, as a last measure. The reply from the MoE is awaited. Meanwhile, the MoE vide its letter No. 21-3/2024-1S.20 dated 07.08.2024 directed the institution to once again formally apply to NCTE for recognition and accordingly, the institution had submitted an offline application to NCTE for consideration of recognition for intake of 100 seats in B.A. B.Ed. / B.Sc. B.Ed. (Four Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme) w.e.f. session 2021-22. The institution has now requested to process its application for grant of recognition prospectively under the existing Integrated 4-year ITEP under Appendix-15. The processing of the application of the institution submitted in the year 2020 & 2021 was not accepted by the Chairperson, NCTE under Regulation 12 of the NCTE Regulations 2014 by not relaxing the mode of submission of application i.e. offline mode. <p>The Committee stress that there are two issues in hand. One is regarding regularisation of the course (B.A. B.Ed. / B.Sc. B.Ed) since session 2021-2022 i.e. retrospectively recognition and another is as to granting recognition transiting these course into ITEP since 2025-26. As stated above, the first issue is pending at MoE level in consultation with NCTE and the 2nd issue is to be considered in the NRC. No need to mention that granting the retrospective recognition by NRC would be contrary to the NCTE Act., 1993.</p> <p>The Committee further deliberate that the institutions which are offering the B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. programme are only eligible for the transition into ITEP. In the instant case, the Institution is offering this course and thus eligible for transition, however, this course has not been recognized by the NCTE. If these course are recognized by MoE retrospectively at later stage, the refusal of recognition of this Govt. Institution under Transition would not be justified.</p> <p>In view of the above facts and circumstances, the Committee decided to refer the matter to NCTE (HQ) to consider the matter as a special one for processing the application of the institution for transition from B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. to ITEP prospectively i.e. since session 2025-2026.</p>

- The Ministry of Education *inter-alia* directed NCTE to invite applications from the UT of J&K and UT of Ladakh from 01.07.2020 to 31.08.2020 and the TEIs functioning in J&K/Ladakh may be allowed to continue as such for the academic session 2020-21.
- NCTE issued Public Notice inviting applications from the UT of J&K & UT of Ladakh between 30.07.2020 to 31.08.2020.
- Central University of Jammu had applied on 31.08.2020 for 4-Year Integrated programme leading to B.A. B.Ed./ B.Sc. B.Ed. degree.
- The Ministry of Education vide letter dated 01.10.2020 directed NCTE to extend the timeline for inviting applications from the UTs of J&K and Ladakh till 20.11.2020.
- NCTE issued another Public Notice dated 07.12.2020 inviting applications from the UTs of J&K & Ladakh between 11.12.2020 to 07.02.2021.
- The Ministry of Education vide letter dated 02.09.2021 granted relaxation under Section 29 of the NCTE Act 1993 to the institutions located in the UTs of J&K and Ladakh until December 2022.
- The Norms and Standards for B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. were omitted from the NCTE Regulations, 2014 *vide* NCTE Notification dated 26.10.2021.
- MoE vide letter dated 15.09.2023 conveyed the approval of the Competent authority u/s 29 of the NCTE Act, 1993 on the proposal of NCTE subject to following conditions:-
 - (i) All the institutions will have to submit compliance to the deficiencies pointed out by NRC on or before 30th October 2023, so as to enable NRC to take final decision on the application of the institution / university.
 - (ii) No admission can be made for the academic session 2024-25 without formal recognition from NRC-NCTE.
- The relaxation will be applicable to all the 140 institutions, as per the list at Annexure of the above-mentioned letter of the NCTE for the course(s) as mentioned against each institution.
- It is further on record that the Central University of Jammu had applied for transition of its courses from B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. to ITEP vide application No. 2526202403042070 and 2526202402191447 for B.Sc.B.Ed. and B.A.B.Ed. respectively in the month of March 2024.
- MoE vide letter No. 21-2/2021-IS.1 dated 22.07.2024 conveyed the approval of the competent authority in the Department as under:

"In order to safeguard the interest of students, the competent authority in the Department has acceded to the proposal of NCTE for granting relaxation to the Teacher Education Institutions (TEIs) located in the UTs of J&K and Ladakh from complying with norms and standards of NCTE upto 31st December 2024. The UT administration may take all necessary steps to ensure compliance of NCTE's norms in future."

The Committee further noted that the name of the Central University of Jammu is not included in the list of 140 institutions sent by NRC to NCTE (HQ). The list of institutions were sent in respect to those institutions only which were offering teacher education programs other than B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. programme as this programme was omitted vide NCTE notification dated 26.10.2021. However, on perusal of the continuous extension by the Ministry, it transpires that the programme(s) being offered by the institutions of UTs of J&K and Ladakh are valid till the session 2024-2025 despite the fact that

		<p>B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed programme were omitted and in deed this is on account of the circumstantial status of UTs of J&K and Ladakh. Needless to mention that the institutions duly recognized by NCTE can only offer the teacher education programme from session 2025-2026.</p> <p>In view of the above circumstances and considering the peculiar situation of UT of J& K and UT of Ladakh, the NRC had decided in its meeting to issue LoI to the Central University of Jammu for B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. course and accordingly, LoI was issued on 14.02.2023.</p> <p>As regards the eligibility to apply for transition into ITEP is concerned, it is mentioned that the institution which are offering the B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. programme are only eligible for the transition into ITEP. In the instant case, the Central University of Jammu is offering this course and thus eligible for transition. Other aspect is that this course has not been recognized by the NCTE in the University, however, still valid in terms of the extension of time line given by the Ministry under which the institutions are required to meet the norms and standard defined by the NCTE amended from time to time.</p> <p>Accordingly, the Committee unanimously concluded the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The course B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. run by the Central University of Jammu has a valid recognition as on date by virtue of the MoE letter dated letter No. 21-2/2021-IS.1 dated 22.07.2024 although it has not been granted formal recognition by NCTE due to omission of N&S for the said course and even also it was not included in the list of 140 institutions. The application of the J&K for grant of recognition of B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. course for which LOI was issued by NRC, may not be processed further rather the University be allowed to transit into ITEP. Inspection of the University has already been conducted on its application for grant of recognition for B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. course. Thus, there is no further need for inspection of this Government Institution. <p>In view of the above and the reply of the institution and the Committee decided the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Letter of Intent (LoI) under clause 7(13) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 prior to grant of formal recognition and compliance of the following provisions as envisaged in NCTE Regulations, 2014 as well as guidelines issued by the NCTE Hqrs. thereof, may be issued. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The institution shall submit the list of faculties having required qualification as per NCTE Regulations 2014 as amended from time to time duly approved by the concerned affiliating body. The institution shall launch its own website with hyperlink to the NCTE website uploading the required information / documents as per clause 7(14) of the NCTE Regulations 2014 as amended time to time and furnish the evidence in this regard.
