WRIT-C No. 8211 of 2019 titled as "Reward Post Graduate College Hanumanganj Thru. Director Vs State of U.P. and ors." before the Hon'ble High Court of judicature at Allahabad, Lucknow Bench being aggrieved by the action of the State Government for not granting affiliation for the Diploma in Elementary Education (D.El.Ed.) course. In the said writ petition, the Hon'ble High Court passed an Order dated 30.07.2024. The operative part of which is as under:</li> </ul> <p><i>"7. Confronted with the impugned order dated 06.12.2021 as well as the communication made by the State Government to NCTE by letter dated 03.10.2023, this court, at this stage, is of the concerned view that the NCTE deserves to be granted another opportunity to re-examine the issues raised by the petitioner with regard to the petitioner institution and pass a fresh order. The copy of the affidavit along with the order dated 23.10.2023 has already been given to the counsel of the NCTE.</i></p> <p><i>Accordingly, let the NCTE looked into the aforesaid matter, and they are granted eight weeks' time to pass the fresh order after giving due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, who may ask to furnish all the documents and materials."</i></p>

- The matter was placed before NRC in its 424<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 01 August 2024, and the Committee decided **that Show Notice be issued under Section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 to the institution to submit reply within 21 days from the date of issue of show cause notice on the following grounds:**
  - The Committee noted that the SCERT, Uttar Pradesh vide letter dated 12.07.2024 has informed the office of NRC that the institution has obtained recognition for D.El.Ed. course of one unit (50 students) from NRC from the academic session 2019-20 based on forged staff list dated 26.02.2018 submitted by it to NRC in reply to the Letter of Intent of NRC. The staff list dated 26.02.2018 was never issued by the SCERT, Uttar Pradesh.
  - The committee decided to provide a reasonable opportunity to the concerned institution for making a written representation before passing an order of withdrawal of recognition of D.El.Ed. course.
- Accordingly Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 13/08/2024.

The institution has submitted reply of Show Cause Notice vide letter dated 26/08/2024. The Committee considered the reply of the institution and has not found the same satisfactory on the following grounds:

- The Committee noted that the institution has obtained recognition for D.El.Ed. course for one unit (50 students) from NRC from the academic session 2019-20 based on forged staff list dated 26.02.2018 submitted by it to NRC in reply to the Letter of Intent of NRC. The SCERT, Uttar Pradesh vide letter dated 12.07.2024 has informed NRC that the staff list dated 26.02.2018 was never issued by the SCERT, Uttar Pradesh.

**Hence, the Committee decided that the recognition granted to the institution for offering D.El.Ed. course be withdrawn under Section 17 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 with effect from the end of academic session next following the date of communication of withdrawal order and the institution shall not be entitled to admit the students from the academic session 2025-2026.**

The meeting is ended with a vote of thanks to the chair.
