

The institution has uploaded Government Notification No.256 of 26.06.1940 which does not clearly establish that the land has been allotted to the institution by the Government of Punjab. The institution has not submitted a Land Use Certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority to use the land for educational purposes. The uploaded document is the Government Notification regarding land. The Non-Encumbrance Certificate uploaded by the institution is from 11.01.2000 to 11.02.2015. The institution was required to upload the latest Non-Encumbrance Certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority indicating that the land is free from all encumbrances. The building plan uploaded by the institution is not legible. The institution was required to submit the Blueprint of approved Building Plan signed by the Competent Govt. Authority indicating the name of the course, name of the institution, Khasra No./Plot No., total land area, total built-up area with the measurements of the Multi-purpose Hall as well as other infrastructural facilities such as classrooms etc. along with approval letter issued by Competent Government Authority. The institution has uploaded a letter issued by the Executive Engineer Division-7 to the effect that the building was constructed in 1890 and since there is no authority to approve the building plan, hence, no approval is required for the said college. This is not acceptable in the light of the NCTE Regulations 2014 which requires the approved Building Plan. 
