- As per decision of NRC in its 311<sup>th</sup> meeting the recognition for B.Ed. course was withdrawn to the institution vide order dated 09/07/2020.
- The institution filed an appeal to NCTE (HQ) under section 18 of NCTE Act, 1993 against withdrawal order dated 09/07/2020. The appellate authority passed an order dated 16/11/2022 and decided that the instant appeal deserves to be rejected and therefore, the impugned withdrawal order dated 09/07/2020 issued by NRC is confirmed.
- The institution has filed Writ Petition No. **W.P. (C) 3614/2023** before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi at New Delhi and Hon'ble Court passed an order dated **07.10.2024 with following direction: -**

*"21. In view thereof, this Court set aside the order dated 09.07.2020 of the NRC and the Appellate Authority's order dated 16.11.2022 and the matter is remanded back to the desk of the original authority i.e., NRC for de novo consideration in view of the extant rules and regulations.*  
*22. Needless to state that the authority concerned shall extend the opportunity of hearing to the petitioner-institution and all necessary consequential proceedings shall follow.*  
*23. The petition is accordingly disposed of.*
- The matter was considered in NRC in its 430 (volume-1) and the Committee decided the following in compliance with the direction of Hon'ble Court:

***The institution may be communicated to participate in the ensuing meeting of the NRC in person to place their points/contentions before the Committee.***


Accordingly, in compliance with the decision of the NRC, an email was sent to the institution on 11.12.2024 with a request to place their points/contentions before NRC in its 431<sup>st</sup> meeting held on 9<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> December, 2024. However, the institution did not participate in the meeting.
- In view of the above, the Committee decided that the institution may be requested again to participate in the forthcoming meeting of the NRC either through online mode or physically to place their points/contentions before the Committee along with all the supporting documents including faculty list approved by the affiliating body. Accordingly, an email was sent to the institution on 28/01/2025. The representative of the institution did not appear for hearing before NRC.
- The institution has submitted a letter dated 24/12/2024 along with the Court order dated 07/10/2024 and details of 1+15 faculty approval letter and affidavit along with marksheet of faculties.
