<p>The original file of the institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, Rules, Regulations, SOP, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Northern Regional Committee.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Committee noted that the institution has deposited the requisite fees for inspection in reference to the Order dated 30.01.2024 passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in CM APPL No. 43975/2023 in W.P. (C) No. 11312/2023, therefore, the Committee decided to constitute on-line Visiting Team for inspection of infrastructural & instructional facilities etc. of the institution and to check the adherence of compliance of conditions stipulated under NCTE Regulations. The Committee also decided that a reminder be issued to the Registrar, Lucknow University and Chhatrapati University with request to intimate the affiliation status of the institution from the year 2009 to till date and also to furnish the faculty list of institution, if approved by the University.

<p>The original file of the institution alongwith Appeal Order, other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Rules, Regulations, SOP, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Northern Regional Committee.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Committee noted the institution has filed another Contempt Petition in Civil Writ Petition No. 8188/2020 with prayer before the Hon'ble High Court to issue notice to the Contemnors calling upon them as to why the contempt proceedings shall not be initiated against them for having willfully and deliberately disobeying the directions contained in para 9.6 and 9.7 of the order dated 07.10.2022 passed by this Hon'ble Court in W.P. (C) No. 8188 of 2020. The Committee, therefore decided to restore recognition of the institution for running two units (100 students) of B.Ed. course until a fresh withdrawal order is passed by the NRC as per NCTE Regulations 2014 and the said restoration will be subject to the outcome of the LPA filed by the office of NRC against the order dated 07.10.2022 passed by the Hon'ble Court of Delhi in W.P. (C) No. 8188 of 2020. <p>Order be issued accordingly.</p> <p>The Committee further decided to constitute on-line Visiting Team for inspection of infrastructural & instructional facilities etc. of the institution and to check the adherence of compliance of conditions stipulated under NCTE Regulations.</p> <p>The Committee also decided the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Registrar of the affiliating University be requested to furnish the list of faculty of B.Ed. course in respect of the said institution, duly approved by it from the academic session 2020-21 onwards. <p>The Committee further decided that the institution be directed to submit the following documents:-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The institution is required to submit latest approval letter of the concerned University/Affiliating Body approving the faculty as mandated in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 along with the latest faculty list for B.Ed. Programme approved by the Registrar of the affiliating body as per the prescribed Format with signature on each page duly substantiated with a copy of the proceeding regarding selection of all the faculty members by the selection committee duly constituted and approved by the competent authority of the affiliating University/body. The staff list shall be accompanied with details of their teaching subject, date of birth, date of selection, date of joining, academic qualifications, teaching experience,

			<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The NRC received total 141 applications from various TEIs located in the State of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh. • NRC processed all the applications and in its various meetings decided to issue SCN/Final SCN, as the case may be, to the institutions concerned based upon deficiencies pointed out. The institution also uploaded their reply through online mode. • On perusal of the reply of the institutions, it is observed that most of the applications are found to be deficient in terms of infrastructural & instructional facilities. • The MoE granted relaxation for extension of timeline to process the applications of the State of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh twice i.e. till December 2022 on first occasion and till October 30th 2023 on second occasion. • Further, the NCTE (HQ), on the recommendations of NRC again requested MoE vide letter dated 26.12.2023 to extend the said relaxation till December 2024 with the following conditions as requested by NRC: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ <i>All the institutions will have to submit compliance to the deficiencies pointed out by NRC on or before 30th October 2023, so as to enable NRC to take final decision on the application of the institution / University.</i> ❖ <i>No admission can be made for the academic session 2024-2025 without formal recognition from NRC-NCTE.</i> ❖ <i>The relaxation will be applicable to all the 140 institutions, as per list below for the course(s) as mentioned against each institution.</i> ❖ <i>The institutions which have not made an application to NRC-NCTE for grant of permission / recognition are not entitled to take admission in any of the Teacher Education Course.</i> • In response, the MoE vide letter dated 22nd July, 2024 granted relaxation till December 2024 as under :- <p style="text-align: center;"><i>“In order to safeguard interests of students, the competent authority in the Department has acceded to the proposal of NCTE for granting relaxation to the Teacher Education institutions (TEIs) located in UTs of J&K and Ladakh from complying with norms and standards of NCTE upto 31st December 2024. The UT administration may take all necessary steps to ensure compliance of NCTE’s norms in future.</i></p> <p>The Committee noted that the majority of the institutions do not have the land on ownership basis in the name of society / trust/institution and the land is in the name of an individual which is further leased to the society /trust/ institution for educational purpose. Also, the institutions do not have Change of Land Use for educational purpose, issued by the District Collector of the District, as per the Policy notified by the Revenue Department, Govt. of Jammu and Kashmir.</p>

<p>The original file of the institution alongwith Appeal Order, other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Rules, Regulations, SOP, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Northern Regional Committee.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Committee noted that the SCERT, Uttar Pradesh <i>vide</i> letter dated 12.07.2024 has informed the office of NRC that the institution has obtained recognition for D.El.Ed. course of one unit (50 students) from NRC from the academic session 2019-20 based on forged staff list dated 26.02.2018 submitted by it to NRC in reply to the Letter of Intent of NRC. The staff list dated 26.02.2018 was never issued by the SCERT, Uttar Pradesh. The Committee decided to provide a reasonable opportunity to the concerned institution for making a written representation before passing an order of withdrawal of recognition of D.El.Ed. course. <p>In view of the above, the Committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued under Section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 to the institution to submit reply within 21 days from the date of issue of show cause notice.</p>

<p>The Committee noted the following facts with regard to the relaxation to the institution/s located in UTs of J&K and Ladakh:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Consequent upon the promulgation of the J&K Reorganization Act 2019, the State of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh came under the purview of NCTE. As per the directions of Ministry of Education <i>vide</i> dated 17th June 2020, the NCTE invited applications twice for various Teacher Education Programmes from the State of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh.

	<p>In view of the above, the Committee unanimously decided to forward the following to NCTE (HQ) for consideration and approval of the Competent Authority:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The online portal for inviting applications from the institutions located in the State of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh be opened for at least a period of 15 days providing one more, last and equal opportunity to all the TEIs located there and running any of the teacher education courses. The institutions which have already applied (are included in the list of 140 institutions) need not apply and to pay processing fees again. The institutions which are included in the list of 140 institutions may upload fresh documents if they require to do so, for which they may be provided one more opportunity by relaxing the provisions of the extant SOP. In the meantime, the <i>status-quo</i> of these 140 institutions be maintained, as such, they may be allowed to take admission for the academic session 2024-25. During such time, the NRC shall process and dispose of all the applications and decide the recognition/permission of all the TEIs prior to start the next academic session.
