

- 3. The institution has submitted the proof of composite issued by Indira Gandhi University, Meerpur, Rewari dated 29.06.2020.
- 4. While going through the file, it was found that the institution has submitted CLU which is issued on dtd. 09/07/2007 signed on 13/07/2007 that too for school.
- 5. The BCC is submitted but the total land area mentioned in the Building plan and the BCC are not matching.
- 6. The BCC is not issued by the competent authority.

Hence, the Committee decided to reject/refuse the application of the institution under section 14/15(3(b) of the NCTE Act, 1993.
