

The NRC made the following <b>observations</b> :-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Land status is not clear by the VT member</li> <li>2. Building plan were not shown properly. It is not clear which building which room are being used for the Education programs. Institute should submit legible plans with all spares/rooms used for various uses for the Education programs. It seems that facilities are scattered on several floors without clear demarcation of school/department premises. Institute should submit clear building plans (approved by the competent authority) over which all rooms / spaces used by the education programs are highlighted.</li> <li>3. Regarding floor wise built up area, the VT expert has stated that in absence of clear building plans, this cannot be verified.</li> <li>4. Institute must strengthen the Labs and facility in Multipurpose Hall (Furniture and Equipment's).</li> <li>5. Provision of Lift should be made available for the vertical movement of Ph. Ch. persons.</li> <li>6. Fire and Life Safety Certificate for Fire Office not available. Institute should obtain Fire Safety Certificate / NOC from the Competent Authority (Govt. Fire Officer).</li> <li>7. Institute must recruit faculty as per NCTE norms. Salary disbursement records should be maintained separately for the Department of Education. As per VT remarks 1) Approval plan as produced is not complete as per standards as required for any approving authority. 2) Drawings are devoid of 4 side elevations, 2 sections, area statement, schedule of opening, foundation details, soak pit/sewerage tank, bore well etc. 3) FAR/FSI are not mentioned in the approval drawings as produced. 4) Approval drawings and physical verification differ from each other, physical deviationist observed. 5) The institute is advised to apply for afresh approval as per the actual construction at site, by the help of a registered architect only. 6) The dimensions and area should be in meters only. Feet's-inches, square foot are not entertained by approving authorities. 7) No proper external dimensions of the building marked in the drawing.</p> <p>(iii) The break-up of the built-up area mentioned in the building plan for the teacher education programmes is not accepted by the VT. As per VT remarks 1) Area shown/marked are inadequate. 2) Approval</p>

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	drawings and physical verification differ from each other; physical deviation is observed. 3) The institutes advised to apply for a fresh approval as per the actual construction at site, by the help of a registered architect only.
(iv)	The institution has not submitted the certificate from the Competent authority that the building has been constructed as per NBC and same is fully safe and structurally sound to run the teacher training course. As per VT remarks Structural Safety Certificate-Not issued by the competent authority. The certificate should be issued by a certified structural engineer only, mentioning the safety codes and norms as per NBC (National Building Code)
(v)	Fire Safety Certificate not accepted by VT as per remarks given by VT as the date of certificate is expired. The letter should be produced in a fire safety department letterhead.
(vi)	The building of the institution is barrier free / accessible certificate not produced and uploaded in the NCTE portal.
(vii)	The floor-wise built-up area is not accepted by VT. As per VT remarks 1) Approval plan as produced is not complete as per standards as required for any approving authority. 2) Approval drawing and physical verification differ from each other; physical deviation is observed.
(viii)	As per VT Human resource as reflected in faculty details column is extremely poor and not at par with NCTE norms. Faculty details not updated, as per the names in portal. Most of them are unavailable. The institution is required to submitted latest/current faculty list approved & signed each page by concerned affiliating body in original with the details of their teaching subject, date of birth, date of selection, date of joining, academic qualifications, teaching experience, NET/Ph.D. (NCTE's GOI dated 09.06.2017), salary structure and related documents duly attested by authorized management representative not submitted. And, notarized original affidavit of Rs. 100/- on non-judicial stamp paper by the management and Rs. 10/- non-judicial stamp paper by each selected/appointed faculty in the NCTE prescribed proforma.
(ix)	The institution has not submitted details of salary disbursed to the faculty along with six months Bank statement and account number of each faculty member.
(x)	The institution is required to submit copies of valid Fixed Deposit Receipts Nationalized/ Scheduled Bank towards Endowment & Reserve Fund in the joint operation mode with RD, NRC, NCTE & Management along with duly field Bank Form "A" in original, verified/ signed by the Manager of the Bank as per NCTE Regulations, 2014.


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	(xi)	The institution is required to submit downloaded copies of documents from the website of the institution with hyperlinks of the same as per provisions of 7(14) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014.
	(xii)	Poor library facility -- Books are inadequate in number, no new books have been purchased since long past, no journals, national documents are kept. Sitting capacity is not up to NCTE norms. There is no computer or photocopy machine in the library.
	(xiii)	Toilets are dirty, shabby, even urinals are not fitted with pipes, no facility for PH persons.
	(xiv)	Multipurpose halls look like a make shift arrangements, not properly furnished with chairs, AV systems
	(xv)	No CCTV in classrooms / corridors, classrooms / ICT lab is not furnished with wall - mounted projectors / smart board. Surprisingly the ICT room was found without electricity.
	(xvi)	Labs are not properly equipped, no purchase of items / equipment since 2015.
	(xvii)	Fire certificate has expired, needs to be reissued.
	(xviii)	Human resources as reflected in faculty details column is extremely poor and not at par with NCTE norms.
	(xix)	The computer lab is not furnished, the institute couldn't switch on the computers as no power cables are connected.
	(xx)	CCTV is not installed in most of the rooms.
	(xxi)	Library seating is inadequate, only some 12-15 chairs are seen.
	(xxii)	The library registers and library books do not match; the institute was unable to produce the books they are asked for.
	(xxiii)	Boys and girl's toilet insufficient. The toilets looked very old and dirty. Insufficient urinals, WC, and wash basin.
	(xxiv)	No provision for physically handicapped students and staff.
	(xxv)	Air exhaust systems (exhaust fans) not seen in the chemistry lab.
	(xxvi)	No proper AV (Audio visual) system in the multipurpose hall.



Therefore, the VT team could not conduct online virtual inspection at the scheduled date.</p> <p>2) As per the request of the institution date of inspection was rescheduled on 04.12.2023 and the institution has again requested through mail to give one week more time as staff is engaged in ongoing B.Ed. admission process of last phase and some of the faculty members are engaged in occasion.</p> <p>The NRC <b>decided</b> the following:-</p> <p>The institution is hereby given the last opportunity through <b>Show Cause Notice</b> before withdrawal of recognition u/s 17 of NCTE Act for conducting inspection of the institution on submission of inspection fee of Rs. 1.5 lakh + 18% GST through the Demand Draft in favour of Member Secretary, NCTE payable at New Delhi within a period of 7 days from the date of issue of the letter.</p>
