SRC, NCTE

At the outset Sh. Madan Singh Yadav, Regional Director, and Convener, SRC welcomed the Chairperson and all other members including special invitees of the APSCHE. The Committee has taken up the following agenda items of Emergent Meeting.

1. Consideration of Court Matter in respect of W.P. No. 2094 of 2023 title-Masha College of Education, Valasapalli Road, Yerraguntla Kadapa District, State of Andhra Pradesh-516309 and other connected matters therein for B.Ed. programme- regarding

In accordance with Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh order dated 12.04.2023, a joint meeting was scheduled by the SRC, NCTE on 24.04.2023 at 11.00am through video conferencing regarding the drafting of common schedule with APSCHE as directed by hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh at Amravati. The decision taken by SRC committee in the said meeting is stated herein below:-

- "(i) The APSCHE shall abide by the Rules and Regulations of the NCTE while conducting inspection. Further inspection shall not be done vaguely/vexatiously.
- (ii) The schedule proposed by the APSCHE for visiting the colleges to extend affiliation for the academic year 2023-24 is approved by the Committee.
- (iii) The APSCHE is required to prepare an Inspection Proforma for the Visiting Team keeping in view the enclosed NCTE Regulations, 2014 for obtaining required documents as per Annexure 'A' and respective Appendix as mentioned in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 and the same shall be shared with the SRC, NCTE before its finalization.
- (iv) The APSCHE shall conduct inspection of the respective TEIs through Visiting Team to obtain the information along with the documentary evidence from the institutions as required in the NCTE Regulation. While constituting the Visiting Team the University shall ensure at least one member should be from the faculty of education. (
- v) After conducting the inspection of the TEIs as per schedule, the APSCHE shall submit the institution wise inspection report to the SRC, NCTE for taking necessary action.

Accordingly, the APSCHE draft schedule of affiliation process for the AY 2023-24 is approved by the SRC, NCTE in its 424th meeting."

However, the matter was listed on 26.04.2023 before the Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh at Amravati. The Standing Counsels submitted to the Hon'ble Court that discussions are going on between different stakeholders which are in progress and require some more time to file the schedule for an inspection by the different Universities which is agreed by the APSCHE and SRC, NCTE.

Thereafter an email was received by office of Regional Director, SRC NCTE from the APSCHE on 27.04.2023 with their request to modify the constitution of visiting team mutually decided in the last SRC meeting (Emergent meeting held on 24.04.2023).

Keeping in view the APSCHE request, SRC NCTE conveyed its Emergent meeting on 03.05.2023 at 11.00 a.m. which was also attended by the Chairperson, APSCHE and his team of officials.

The SRC discussed in detail and reiterated that at least one member belonging to the discipline of teacher education be ensured on the Visiting Team to be constituted by the University. The APSCHE Chairperson stated that in his state the required number of senior faculty in teacher education are not available and made a request to SRC, NCTE to suggest a panel of senior teacher educator from

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neighbouring states. The SRC agreed to provide a penal of expert from the discipline of teacher education available in the neighbouring state.

Moreover, the other modifications suggested by the APSCHE are also agreed by the SRC, NCTE.

The meeting ended with the vote of thanks to the Chair.

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
