Hence, the petitioners, in all the Writ Petitions are directed to submit/offer their explanation to the show cause notice dated 02 & 03.03.2023 within a period of four (4) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, on receiving such explanation for the show cause notice dated 02 & 03.03.2023, the 3rd respondent is directed to consider and examine the explanation and pass appropriate orders thereon, in accordance with the provision of the Act 1993 and communicate the decision to the petitioner-institution within a period of eight (8) weeks therefrom. With the above directions, all the Writ Petitions are disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs."

The SRC considered the entire matter and noted that as the recognition of the institution has already been withdrawn by SRC vide order dated 08.03.2021, the institution has not approached the Appellate Authority against the decision of SRC, the earlier withdrawal order issued to the institution stands and no further action is required to be taken by SRC in this regard.
