1. Omsai Com B.Ed. College, Plot/Khasara No. 4-17 (S No. 77), Street No. 4-17, Maddi Post, Padmanabham Taluk & City, Vishakhapatnam District – 531219, Andhra Pradesh

File No. SRCAPP14227 Course - B.Ed.

The original file of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, the SRC after careful consideration made the following observations: -

In obedience of order dated 26.07.2024 in WP No. 12364 of 2024 by Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh, the SRC considered the matter along with Court's direction and decided to Grant Provisional Recognition for additional 50 seats to Omsai Com B.Ed College, subject to the outcome of WP 12364/2024. As per the direction of the Court, the College is also directed to inform the students that their admissions are subject to the result of the Writ Petition.

The original file of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, the SRC after careful consideration made the following observations: -

In obedience of order dated **06.08.2024** in **WP No. 17068** of **2024** by Hon'ble High Court of **Andhra Pradesh**, SRC considered the matter along with the decision of Hon'ble Court in WP No. 17825/2022 dated 28.03.2024 and the proceedings of the Vice Chancellor dated 17.05.2024 inter-alia reducing the intake strength from 100 to 50 w.e.f. the academic session 2017-18. The Committee decided to issue Show Cause Notice on the following grounds:-

- 1. The recognition of the institution was withdrawn vide order dated 31.12.2021 on the following grounds:-
  - (a) The institution has submitted photocopy of faculty list approved by DEAN Faculty of Education Adikavi Nannaya University. The same shall be approved by the Registrar of the affiliating University.
  - (b) The institution has not submitted latest consolidated Staff list (D.Ed., B.Ed., M.Ed.) duly approved by the Registrar of the affiliating body as per the prescribed Format.
  - (c) The institution did not submit details of administrative and professional staff as required under clause 5.3 of Appendix 4 of NCTE Regulations, 2014 for B.Ed. course.
  - (d) The institution did not submit proof of disbursement of salary to faculty & non-teaching staff through bank account as required under clause 10(2) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.
  - (e) The website of the institution is not uploaded with the information required under clauses 7(14)(i), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.
  - (f) The institution has not submitted "Form A" issued by the respective Bank Manager towards creation of FDR of Rs.7 lakh and 5 lakh, totalling Rs.12 lakh towards Endowment Fund & Reserve Fund into joint account for a duration of 5 years along with a copy of the FDRs
  - (g) The institution has submitted notarized photocopy of land documents, NEC which are in regional language. However English translated copy of the same not submitted by the institution.
  - (h) The institution has submitted photocopy of Building Plan but the same is not readable.
- 2. The Committee has observed that the above deficiencies have not been addressed by the institution till date and the institution did not

- submit any document regarding removal of the deficiencies.
- 3. The Committee has also observed that the above deficiencies pertained to the institution established that the institution is lacking with infrastructural and instructional facilities which is essentially required to be maintained under NCTE Regulations, 2014 and the institution has compromised with the quality of teacher education.

Therefore, the Committee decided to issue **Show Cause Notice u/s 17** of **NCTE Act**, 1993 before withdrawal of the recognition on the grounds mentioned above to the institution. The institution is required to submit the documents within 21 days from the date of issue of **Show Cause Notice.** 

3. Gurukul College of Education, No.1241, Sri Ganesha Complex, Gokulam 3<sup>rd</sup> Stage, Near Trinetra Circle, Mysore-570002, Karnataka

File No. APS02383, Course – B.Ed.

The original file of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, the SRC after careful consideration made the following observations: -

In obedience of order dated **08.08.2024** in **WP No. 5538 of 2024** by Hon'ble High Court of **Karnataka** the SRC considered the matter & observed that the letter dated 08.12.2023 was not found attached with required documents thus, in regards to the Court direction, the SRC Committee decided to Issue Show Cause Notice to the Institute for submission of the following documents:-

- 1. The institution is required to submit certified copy of land documents issued by concerned Tehsildar /Revenue Officer. (If the same are in Regional Language the institution is also required to submit notarised copy of English version of land documents)
- 2. The institution is required to submit an attested/notarised copy of Land Use Certificate issued by the Competent Authority.
- The institution is required to submit a copy of Non-Encumbrance Certificate issued by the Competent Authority duly attested / notarised.
- 4. The institution is required to submit an attested/notarised copy of the approved Building Plan (if institution is running more than one Teacher Education programme, it shall be required to submit an exclusive earmarked building plan for each of the recognised Teacher Education programme)
- 5. An attested/notarised copy of site plan showing all the Plot/Survey No. mentioned in the land documents in one location

along with land area and built-up area is required to be submitted.

- 6. The institution is required to submit an attested/notarised copy of Building Completion Certificate issued by the competent authority.
- 7. The institution is required to submit latest Staff list duly approved by the Registrar of the affiliating body as per the prescribed Format. (In case the institution is running more than one teacher education programme, it is required to submit staff list duly approved by the Affiliating body for each of the recognised teacher education programme being run by the Institution.)
- 8. The institution is required to submit copy of FDRs to the SRC, NCTE. The institution is required to submit a "Form A" (in Original) issued by the respective Bank Manger towards creation of FDR of Rs.7 lakh and 5 lakh, totalling Rs.12 lakh towards Endowment Fund & Reserve Fund into joint account for a duration of 5 years along with a copy of the FDRs.

- 13. The Affidavit should be supported with documents like certified photocopy of passbook from Bank of each of faculty showing the disbursement of salary through bank account to individual faculty members (at-least for the last 3 months).
- 14. The institution shall be required to submit an Affidavit clearly

stating status about land & building and Management (Society/Trust) at the time of recognition and its present status giving following details

- (i) Details of land & building available at the time of recognition with the institution.
- (ii) Details of land & building now available with the institution.
- (iii) Status of Management at the time of recognition and its present status.

In case of change of land & building or the Management at the time of recognition and thereafter the institution is required to specify the reason thereof with approval of the SRC, NCTE.

Therefore, the Committee decided to issue **Show Cause Notice u/s 17** of **NCTE Act**, 1993 before withdrawal of the recognition on the grounds mentioned above to the institution. The institution is required to submit the documents within 21 days from the date of issue of **Show Cause Notice.** 

4. Sri Venkateswara Bala Kuteer College of Education, Chetanpuri, Chowdavaram, Guntur-522019, Andhra Pradesh

The original file of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, the SRC after careful consideration made the following observations: -

In compliance of the Court order dated 19.08.2024 in WP No. 17384 of 2024 passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh, the institution's representation dated 20.07.2024 & 03.09.2024 along with the documents submitted was considered and Committee decided to issue continuation order of the institution i.e., Sri Venkateswara Bala Kuteer College of Education, Survey No. 399, 396-12/1, 398, 396/11 Kothapalem, Chetanpuri, Chowdavaram, Guntur District-522019, Andhra Pradesh for B.Ed. programme for 2 basic units of 50 students each.

The original file of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to

time, the SRC after careful consideration made the following observations: -

In obedience of order dated **12.08.2024** in **WP No. 28988 of 2023** by Hon'ble High Court of **Karnataka** the SRC considered the matter & observed the following decision taken by the Council of NCTE in its 55<sup>th</sup> meeting under Agenda Item No. 5:-

- (i) At present, there are several institutions which have been recognized by the Regional Committee of NCTE wherein courses / programme, other than diploma level courses, are running, An Expert Committee be constituted to devise the modalities for conversion of these recognized institutions into multidisciplinary institutions in line with NEP 2020.
- (ii) The applications pending before the Regional Committees of NCTE shall not be processed further. Hence, all such pending applications before RCs at any stage of processing be returned along with the processing fee to the concerned institution(s).
- (iii) In the cases where the applications are being processed / reopened as per the directions of the Hon'ble Court(s), the concerned Regional Committee shall file a review / appeal before the Hon'ble Court(s) alongwith stay application against the order passed by the Hon'ble Court(s) for processing of application(s) in view of the decision of the Council as taken in II above.

The Committee also deliberated that as per NCTE Act, the General Body / Council was established with a view to achieving planned and coordinated development of the teacher education system throughout the country and as per Section 12 of the Act, it is the duty of the Council to take all such steps as it may think fit for ensuring planned and coordinated development of teacher education and for the determination and maintenance of standards for teacher education. The above quoted decision taken by the Council are required to be adhered by all the Regional Committees.

In view of the above, SRC decided that RD, SRC file a Writ Appeal before the Hon'ble High Court of Karnataka along with the stay application against the order dt. 12.08.2024 in view of the 55<sup>th</sup> GB Meeting of NCTE citing full analogy of the decision of GB / Council in it. The writ appeal be filed at the earliest.

In compliance of the Court order dated 08.08.2024 in WP No. 2329 of 2024 passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Karnataka, the institution representation / Application dated 03.09.2024 submitted by the 'Sri Parshwanath College of Education for Women, Ajjhally P.O, Channagiri, Davanagere-577213, Karnataka for shifting of its premisses. The Committee decided to constitute the online <u>Visiting Team</u> u/s 8(9) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 for inspection of infrastructure & instructional facilities etc. available at new premises at Sri Parshwanath College of Education for Women, Survey No. 123/37, Kote Road, Shivamogga – 577202, Karnataka.

7. K.Negi Reddy College of Education, Plot No. 62,63/1, Dupadu Village, Lakshmipuram Post Office, Kallur Taluk, Kurnool District-518218, Andhra Pradesh

The original file of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, the SRC after careful consideration made the following observations: -

In View of the order dated 06.07.2024 in WP No. 15835 of 2024, SRC has taken note of the ongoing proceedings and observed that no direction is made towards NCTE/SRC. The Committee has decided that in case any instructions of Hon'ble High Court are directed towards SRC the matter can be to put up the matter again in future for discussion.

8. St. Justins College of Education, 161-A, Kamaraja Salai, Madurai – 62509, TamilNadu

**File No.** AOSO0442, APSO6134 **Course** – B.Ed., M.Ed.

The original file of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, the SRC after careful consideration made the following observations: -

The institution was issued a Show Cause Notice dated 30.08.2024. The institution has submitted its reply vide letter dated 16.08.2024. The Committee perused the reply submitted by the institution and found the following deficiencies. In light of the NCTE Rules and Regulations, SRC Committee decided to provide Second Opportunity (as per SoP of NCTE) to the College and issue Final Show Cause Notice in order to comply with the deficiencies.

1. The institution has submitted building plan which is not legible at all. Further, the approving authority of the building plan is also not clear.

- The institution has submitted building completion certificate which is not in proper format and built up area of the institution is also not mentioned. Further, the BCC is also not approved by the competent authority.
- **3.** The institution submitted the approval of the faculty issued by the affiliating university in phrases and issued in different years. The institution is directed to submit notarized copy of consolidated Latest staff list duly approved by the Registrar of the affiliating body as per the prescribed Format for both B.Ed. and M.Ed. courses.
- **4.** The institution has submitted the photocopy of Form 'A' issued by the Senior Manager of bank. The stamp of the manager is not legible and the form is issued without mentioning the date of issuance. The institution is directed to submit the same again.
- **5.** The website of the institution is not uploaded with the information required under clauses 7(14)(i), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.
- 6. Bank statement regarding proof of disbursement of salary to all faculty through bank account has not been submitted. The institution has submitted copies of letters issued by the institute to bank in this regard. The institution is directed to submit the bank statement of all individual faculty and the back statement of institution's bank account duly certified by the bank as required under clause 10(2) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.
- **7.** The institution submitted Non-Encumbrance Certificate issued in the local language. The institution is required to submit the notarized English translation of the same.
- 8. The institution failed in submission of Fire Safety Certificate and certificate regarding building compatible for differently abled persons.

Therefore, the Committee decided to issue **Final Show Cause Notice u/s 17 of NCTE Act**, 1993 before withdrawal of the recognition on the grounds mentioned above to the institution. The institution is required to submit the documents within 15 days from the date of issue of **Final Show Cause Notice.** 

9. Roja D.Ed College, Khasra/Plot No. 926, Main Road, Koilakuntla Village & Post, Koilakuntla Taluk and Town, Kurnool District-518134 Andhra Pradesh

In obedience of order dated 06.08.2024 in WP No. 16475 of 2013 by Hon'ble High Court Andhra Pradesh the SRC considered the matter & observed the following decision taken by the Council of NCTE in its 55<sup>th</sup> meeting under Agenda Item No. 5:-

- (i) At present, there are several institutions which have been recognized by the Regional Committee of NCTE wherein courses / programme, other than diploma level courses, are running, An Expert Committee be constituted to devise the modalities for conversion of these recognized institutions into multidisciplinary institutions in line with NEP 2020.

The original file of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, the SRC after careful consideration made the following observations: -

In compliance of the Court order dated 21.02.2024 in WP No. 4581 of 2024 passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh, the institution's representation dated 10.02.2024 & 03.09.2024 along with the documents submitted was considered and Committee decided to issue continuation order of the institution i.e., Jyothisri College of Education, Survey No. 99/1, 10th Block, Kandulapuram Village, Cumbum Post Office, Cumbum Taluk & City, Prakasam District-523333, Andhra Pradesh for B.Ed. programme for 2 basic units of 50 students each.

The Committee decided to recommend NCTE Hqrs. for conducting online inspection of the institution for verification of infrastructural and instructional facilities available in the institution at the earliest.
