At the outset Sh. Mukesh Kumar, Regional Director and Convener, SRC, NCTE welcomed the Chairperson and all other members and apprised about the work done by the SRC, NCTE along with the directions received from the NCTE Hqrs. from time to time.

The Committee has taken up the following agenda items of 437th Emergent Meeting.

1.	Hindi Prachar Kendra College of Teacher Education, Puliparambu, Kodungallur, Thrissur District – 680 664, Kerala. File No. APSO3885, Course - B.Ed. The original file of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the orders passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala, the SRC after careful consideration made the following observations: - The RD, SRC, NCTE apprised the Committee that the following action has been taken in line to defend the interest of NCTE before the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala in the matter :- NCTE has engaged Shri. N. N. Sugunapalan, a Senior Advocate, to defend the actions of SRC, NCTE in the Writ Appeal as well as the Contempt Petition. Shri. N. N. Sugunapalan, Senior Advocate suggested the following :-

	<p>The contempt proceedings to be adjourned and in the meanwhile the order passed by the Hon'ble Single Judge in W.P. No. 11427/2022 be implemented by the SRC, NCTE subject to the outcome of the Appeal, with specific mention that the permission of change of management / trust / society is subject to outcome of the Appeal filed by the NCTE before the Divisional Bench of Hon'ble High Court of Kerala. The implementation this decision is apprised to the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala during the course of hearing the Contempt Petition on 21.05.2024 and the same is granted by the Hon'ble Court.</p> <p>The SRC decided that the suggestions of Senior Advocate are considered and be implemented immediately to avoid adverse remarks of Hon'ble High Court in the Contempt Petition, hence, the permission to change the management is hereby granted provisionally subject to the outcome of Writ Appeal filed by the NCTE and the SLP before the Hon'ble Apex Court (if filed by the NCTE in future).</p>
2.	<p>Inclusion of newly established State Universities in the data base and portal of NCTE.</p> <p>The SRC noted that in the Southern States of the Country, some Universities have come into existence and requires updating in the portal and data base of NCTE. The following Universities have come into existence recently by the Karnataka State Universities (Amendment) Act, 2022, dated 10.10.2022 :-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Bagalkot University, Mudhot Road, Jamkhandi, Bagalkote, Karnataka – 587301.2. Bidar University, Bidar Gnyana Karanji, Halhalli, Bhalki, Bidar, Karnataka – 585414.3. Kodagu University, Jnana Kaveri Campus, Chikka aluvara, Kushalnagar, Kodagu, Karnataka – 571232.4. Chamarajanagara University, Bedarapura, Badanaguppe, Karnataka - 571313.5. Hassan university, Kenchatavalli, Karnataka – 573220.6. Vijayanagara Sri Krishnadevaraya University, Koppal, Karnataka.7. Haveri University, Kerimattihalli, Karnataka – 581110. <p>The above State Universities have been established by the State Act and have powers of affiliation in their respective districts under their jurisdiction. It has come to the notice and specifically the Bagalkot University vide letter No. BGKUJ/RO/2023-24/853, dated 20.03.2024 made the request to include their names in the application portal of ITEP</p>
