Programme to 4-year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) for the session 2025-26 along with related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents uploaded by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC, NCTE.</p> <p>The Azim Premji University, Bangalore, Karnataka was granted recognition vide order dated 03.03.2018 for B.Sc. B.Ed. course with an intake of 2 units under Appendix-13 of NCTE Regulations, 2014 (now omitted).</p> <p>The University was granted recognition on the basis of clarification received from NCTE Hqrs. vide letters dated 07.09.2017 and 03.10.2017</p>

on the applicability of Amended NCTE Regulations, dated 28.04.2017.

The operative part of the clarification letter of Hqrs., dated 3.10.2017 is as under :-

*“...the first proviso of the NCTE notification dated 28<sup>th</sup> April, 2017 provides that **“Provided that in case of Central or State Government Institutions or Universities, recognition may be accorded for a period of five years, on land or premises, which is leased to them.”** And the second proviso of the NCTE Notification dated 28.04.2017 provides that **“Provided further that such institutions shall be required to shift to premises with own land and building thereon, in conformity with the specifications in these regulations within a period of five years from the date of recognition.”** From the above provisions, it does not make it mandatory that the leased premises should be necessarily leased for 5 years. It is merely mandated that the recognition should not be for more than 5 years on such leased premises. IN fact the intention behind such an amendment is revealed in the second proviso which makes it clear that such an institution having been recognized would necessarily shift to owned premises within 5 years of such recognition. Thus in the case of the applicant, M/s Azim Premji University, if the lease itself is for 3 years then it could be directed that either they shift to owned premises within 3 years or they will provide evidence of lease beyond 3 years in case they are intending to shift to owned premises after a period of 3 years from recognition, but in any case before 5 years from recognition. Hence as per the legal opinion and the clarification given above, you are requested to place this clarification before the Chairperson, SRC for consideration.*

*This issues with the approval of the Chairperson, NCTE.”*

The NCTE has invited applications seeking transition of B.Sc.B.Ed. course to Integrated Teacher Education Programme and the Azim Premji University, Bangalore, Karnataka and had submitted an application (No. 2526202403052090) through online portal.

Scrutiny of application submitted by the University for transition reveals the following:-

*“The University has submitted Lease Deed dated `10.06.2013 executed between the Azim Premji Trust having registered office at Doddakkanneli, Sarjapur Road, Bangalore (Lessor) and Azim Premji University having registered office at Doddakkanneli, Sarajapur Road, Bangalore (Lessee) totally measuring 81.5125 acres of land at Boorgunte village, Sarjapur Hobli, Anekal Taluk, Bangalore. The period of Lease Deed is for 30 years w.e.f. 01.06.2013 till 31.05.2043.”*

The Committee observed that clause 8(4)(1) of NCTE Regulations, 2014

is relevant which is reproduced below :-

*“No institution shall be granted recognition under these regulations unless the institution or society sponsoring the institution is in possession of required land on the date of application. The land free from all encumbrances could be either on ownership basis or on lease from Government or Government institutions for a period of not less than thirty years. In cases where under relevant State or Union territory laws the maximum permissible lease period is less than thirty years, the State Government or Union territory administration law shall prevail and in any case no building shall be taken on lease for running any teacher training programme.”*

The Committee considered the matter and arrived the following conclusions :-

1. The Lease Deed and other documents submitted by the University executed between private party and the University as stipulated under clause 8(4)(i) of NCTE Regulations 2014 is not permissible.
2. The University had to shift to its own premises within a period specified by the NCTE Hqrs. vide letter dated 07.09.2017 and 03.10.2017 and as per amended Regulations 2017.

On the grounds mentioned above, the SRC, NCTE decided to issue Show Cause Notice to Azim Premji University seeking clarifications from the institution with an direction to submit its representation through online portal only within 21 days.
