That being so, they will not be eligible to apply for M.Ed. reject their request.</i></p> <p><i>(iv) The institution submitted its representation vide letter dt. 18.03.2024 citing the reason that they have not received any communication from SRC on their application submitted in 2016 and requested SRC to kindly consider their application of M.Ed. for issuance of Letter of Intent.</i></p> <p><i>(v) The request of the institution was considered by SRC in its 435th meeting held on 03rd April, 2024, wherein the SRC decided as under:-</i></p> <p><i>The Committee noted that the application of the institution has already been rejected vide letter dated 22.03.2016 on the following grounds :-</i></p> <p><i>1. They do not have University affiliated course running 5 years or more. That being so, they will not be eligible to apply for M.Ed. Reject their request.</i></p> <p><i>The institution made a fresh request vide letter dated 18.03.2024 for issuance of Letter of Intent. In this regard, the Committee considered that the decision taken by the 59th meeting of the General Body of NCTE held on 04.12.2023 under Agenda Item No. 4 is relevant and reproduced below :-</i></p> <p><i>“The applications for M.Ed. and M.P.Ed. courses which are returned in light of decision taken by the General Body in its 55th meeting and which are received and pending as on the date of 59th GB Meeting i.e. 04.12.2023 in RCs should be processed further by the Regional Committees for grant</i></p>

of recognition as per norms and standard prescribed by NCTE.”

The committee noted that the application of the institution does not fall in the category of “pending” and accordingly is not liable to be considered as per the decision of the GB quoted above.

In view of the above, the Committee decided that the request of the institution made by vide its letter dated 18.03.2024 is hereby rejected.

(vi) The institution filed a Writ Petition, 11138/2024 wherein the Hon’ble Court vide order dated 18.07.2024 directed as follows:

“It is hereby instructed to the 2nd respondent to examine the representation dated 18.03.2024 of the petitioner and pass appropriate order in accordance with law and communication the said decision within a period of three months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.”

(vii) The matter was considered by SRC in its 441st Meeting held on 04th August 2024 wherein the SRC decided as under :-

In light of the directions received from the Hon’ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh in W.P. No. 11138 of 2024 vide order dated 18.07.2024, and in furtherance to representation made on 18.03.2024. The SRC decided to provide an opportunity before refusing the grant of recognition u/s 15(3)(b) of NCTE Act, 1993 and the institution is directed to submit a representation in writing on the following grounds within a period of 30 days from the date of issue of notice :-

- 1. Proof of submission of application seeking accreditation from NAAC as required under clause 2 of Appendix-5 of NCTE Regulations, 2014.*
- 2. The institution do not fulfil the criteria of “composite institution” as required under clause 2(b) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.*

(viii) Accordingly, the letter dated 22.08.2024 was issued to the institution.

The institution vide representation dated 11.09.2024 and 27.12.2024 has submitted the reply which was considered by SRC in its 452nd meeting held on 24th February 2025, wherein the SRC decided as under :-

- The Visiting Team be constituted for inspection of the institution u/s 15 of the NCTE Act for proposed M.Ed course, on payment of re-inspection fee of Rs. 1.50 lacs + GST.**

3. Further two complaints dated 26.09.2023 and 30.10.2023 were received from Mohammed Abdul Bari against the Soghra College of Teacher Education.

4. The SRC in its 430th meeting held on 01st December 2023 considered the matter and committee decided under:-

The SRC directed the RD, SRC to send a reminder letter to the Registrar, M.G. University, Nalgonda, (TS) and obtain its report on the allegation alleged by the complainant alongwith status of functioning of the institution as per provisions of the NCTE regulations, 2014 for onward transmission to the Public Grievance Cell of PMO”.

5. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a letter was issued to the M.G. University on 15.12.2023.

6. Based on the decision uploaded in the website, the University has already submitted its reply to SRC vide letter dated 11.12.2023. The reply received from the University along with a complaint letter dated 22.12.2023 was considered by SRC in its 431st meeting held on 10th January, 2024 wherein the SRC decided as under:-

“The Committee noted that based on the complaints received against the institution, SRC has requested the Registrar, Mahatma Gandhi University, Telangana to provide report on the institution in light of the allegations made.

The Registrar, Mahatma Gandhi University vide its letter dated 11.12.2023 has submitted its report. The report of the University was considered by SRC and observed that the University administration has verified the genuineness of the documents of the institution. Therefore, SRC decided that the status quo of recognition granted to the institution shall be maintained.

Further, SRC has been receiving many complaints from a Complainant making allegations. In this regard, SRC decided to forward all the complaints to the University to take necessary action before according affiliation to the institution.”

7. The Mahatma Gandhi University vide letter dated 27.03.2024 has issued a letter to the institution calling for explanation within 10 days from the issue of the letter.

8. The SRC in its **436th Meeting** of SRC held on **02nd& 03rd May, 2024** considered the matter and decided to issue Show Cause Notice to the institution on following grounds :-

On perusal of the report Lr. No. B1/Special/ZPP dated 10.11.2023

	<p><i>submitted by the Zilla Praja Parishad Office, Nalgonda forwarded by the Registrar, Mahatma Gandhi University, Nalgonda, TS vide letter No. 287/MGU/AAC/NLG/2023-24 dated 27.03.2024, the Committee decided to send the First Show Cause Notice to the institution to submit the representation along with all supporting documents on the findings of the report.</i></p> <p>9. Further, the SRC noted the following :-

1. The Clause 2.1 of Appendix 10 of NCTE Regulations 2014 stipulate the following :-
“The institutions or academic units specially established for offering ODL programmes like National Open University, State Open Universities and the Directorates / School of Open and Distance Learning in UGC recognised universities shall be eligible to offer this teacher education programme (The Deemed to be Universities, Agricultural, Technical or allied Universities, which specialise in a field other than teacher education and other discipline specific Universities/ Institutions are not eligible to offer teacher education programmes through ODL)”

2. The Shanmugha Arts, Science, Technology & Research Academy (SASTRA), Thanjavur-613402, Tamilnadu (APS03910) is a Deemed to be University, hence not eligible to offer B.Ed -DE as per above clause of NCTE Regulations 2014.

Accordingly, the SRC decided to issue Show Cause Notice u/s 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 to Shanmugha Arts, Science, Technology & Research Academy (SASTRA), Thanjavur-613402, Tamilnadu (APS03910) for B.Ed–Distance Education course on the above grounds.
