At the outset Sh. Mukesh Kumar, Regional Director and Convener, SRC, NCTE welcomed the Chairperson and all other members of SRC-NCTE.

With the permission of Chair, Sh. Mukesh Kumar, Regional Director and Convener, SRC, NCTE presented the Agenda before the Committee. Item wise decision taken with regard to cases is as under :-

1.	<p>Consideration of the cases of institutions which have not submitted Performance Appraisal Report (PAR) for the academic session 2021-2022</p>
	<p>1. Under Section 12 (k) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the following is mandated as one of the functions of the Council:</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>(k) evolve suitable performance appraisal system, norms and mechanism for enforcing accountability on recognised institutions;</i></p> <p>2. In view of the above provision, the GB in its 61st Meeting held on 05.08.2024 deliberated on the agenda in detail and approved the following:</p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">I. <i>“Online PAR Module which is to be filed by the recognised institutions.</i></p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">II. <i>Replica of the Online PAR Module</i></p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">III. <i>General Instructions for filling up the PAR</i></p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">IV. <i>Public Notice for the recognised institutions to submit PAR for the Academic Session(s) 2021-22 & 2022-23</i></p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">V. <i>Format of certificate to be obtained from the affiliating body by the institution concerned that the institution is affiliated to it and is following all the Norms and Standards of NCTE for Course Recognized by NCTE.</i></p> <p style="margin-left: 80px;">a. <i>.....Apart from the above, the Council Authorized the Chairperson, NCTE to decide the timeline for submission of PAR by the recognized TEIs and for any further alteration and deletion in the</i></p>

Online PAR Module as per requirement for the aforesaid and subsequent academic session(s)”

3. In pursuance of the decision taken by the Council in 61st **General Body Meeting** held on **05.08.2024**, a Public Notice dated 09.09.2024 was issued that required all the recognised Teacher Education Institutions (TEIs) to submit Performance Appraisal Report (PAR) for academic session(s) 2021-22 and 2022-23 on the online NCTE portal. The deadline to submit PAR was 10.11.2024 and the same was further extended to 10.12.2024 and subsequently to 31.12.2024 vide public notice dated 7.11.2024 and 10.12.2024 respectively.

4. In addition to the public notices, multiple attempts through press releases, regular reminders and video messages of both the Chairperson and Member Secretary of NCTE, uploaded across all major social media platforms with complete guide/tutorial for filling PAR were made to spread awareness and sensitize all the recognized teacher education institutions to for timely submission of their PAR.

The SRC deliberated the entire matter in detail and decided that Show Cause Notice u/s 17 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 be issued to the institutions which have not submitted PAR for the academic session 2021-22 to submit reply within 15 days for non-submission of PAR for the Academic Session 2021-22.

The SRC further decided that the SRC office should expedite the process of preparing the list of institutions which have not submitted the PAR for the Academic session 2022-23 and place before SRC for decision.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the Chair.
