The Original file of the institution along with original documents and records submitted by the institution, NCTE Act 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued from time to time were carefully considered by SRC. It has been observed that the inspection report of Chinmaya Vishwavidyapeeth (Deemed to be University), Ernakulam, Kerala and other documents were considered by SRC and Letter of Intent was issued on 26.09.2019. Further, the institution has submitted reply to LOI on 21.10.2019 and 22.11.2019. The SRC in its  $383^{\rm rd}$  Meeting held during 7 - 9 January, 2020 has considered the said replies and decided to grant recognition to the institution with conditions for the following courses :

- (i) B.Sc. B.Ed (Mathematics) 1 Unit (50 Students)
- (ii) B.A. B.Ed (English) 1 Unit (50 Students)

The decision of according Recognition to the above institution was taken by SRC well within the time stipulation of 3<sup>rd</sup> March as directed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

- 13. The institution shall be required to submit an Affidavit clearly stating status about land & building and Management (Society/Trust) at the time of recognition and its present status giving following details
  - (iv) Details of land & building available at the time of recognition with the Institution
  - (v) Details of land & building now available with the Institution
  - (vi) Status of Management at the time of recognition and its present status

In case of change of land & building or the Management at the time of recognition and thereafter the institution is required to specify the reason thereof with approval of the SRC, NCTE.

Therefore, the Committee decided to issue **Show Cause Notice u/s 17 of NCTE Act**, 1993 before withdrawal of the recognition on the grounds mentioned above to the institution. The institution is required to submit the documents within 21 days from the date of issue of **Show Cause Notice.** 

## **Resolutions**

- (i) The SRC resolved that operation of ITEP portal account of the Chairperson, SRC, NCTE on behalf of the SRC, shall be operated by the Regional Director, SRC as per decision taken by the SRC through minutes of the 387<sup>th</sup> meeting for further necessary action.
- (ii) The SRC discussed the issue of institution offering Teacher Education programmes without obtaining recognition from the NCTE. In this regard, the Regional Director, SRC, NCTE is advised to write a letter to the Secretary, Education, & Director, SCERT of the State / UT in the jurisdiction of Southern Regional Committee to provide the list of such institution in their respective State / UT (if there are any). This may be treated as most urgent.
- (iii) The SRC office shall ensure that in the case of issuance of Continuation Order in RPRO/Shifting orders etc. the order should invariably mentioned the address as per the latest Building Completion Certificate with Sy.No./Khasra No./Plot No. etc. submitted by the institution.
- (iv) The Committee also directed the Regional Director, SRC, NCTE to issue SCN/FSCN to all teacher educations institutions under jurisdiction of the SRC, NCTE as per decision taken 381<sup>st</sup> meeting, placing of all ODL matters etc. as per the advisory informed to RD, SRC during the meeting.
