**The SRC also made the following resolutions: -**

1. The Regional Director is advised to issue a Public Notice to all the TEIs under the jurisdictional area of SRC directing that the management should not borrow any loan or hypothecate the property owned by the institution or management trust / society. Further, they are also directed not to raise any loan on the FDRs being maintained towards Endowment and Reserve Funds. If any management indulge in such an irregularity, the recognition will be withdrawn without any further notice.
2. The RD, SRC is also advised to write to the Registrar of the affiliating Universities which approve the faculty list both for B.Ed., M.Ed., B.P.Ed. and M.P.Ed. courses verify the credentials of the staff members meticulously and ensure that they are not working elsewhere or given their certificates to another institution. Further, a request is also required to be made to the affiliating Universities to ensure that all the approved faculty are available in the institution on all the working days.



3. As the Govt. of Kerala did not respond to the letter sent to Calicut University about functioning of teacher education centres without obtaining recognition from NCTE. The SRC in its meeting resolved to inform the Registrar, Calicut University and also Govt. of Kerala not to allow any teacher education institution offering teacher education programme(s) without obtaining recognition from the NCTE and if they do so they will be held responsible and students come out of such institutions with a degree or diploma in teacher education are not eligible to teach in any recognized school in the Republic of India.
