BCC approved by the competent authority for offering B.A.B.Ed. and B.Sc.B.Ed. for unit is not uploaded by the institution. **Building Completion Certificate for** details provided the bγ institution having 3 floors is not uploaded by the institution.

In view of the above deficiencies, the SRC decided to issue Show Cause Notice seeking clarification from the institution with a direction to submit its representation within 21 days.

Hence the institution is not eligible for transition to the integrated 4-vear teacher programme education (ITEP). Therefore, before rejecting the application of the institution for transition, the SRC decided to issue Show Cause **Notice** seeking clarification from the institution with a direction to submit its representation within 21 days.

- Land document submitted at the time of grant of recognition for offering B.Sc.B.Ed. Course was for Sy.Nos. 142.3, 140.3B, 140.6, 140.5A having 3.02 acres of land. The Sy.No. mentioned in the application for transition to ITEP is 3/96 which is different from that of the Sy.No. which was considered at the time of grant of recognition to B.Sc.B.Ed. course.
- Photocopy of the land document uploaded in in Tamil language. Notarized English version of land document is not submitted by the institution.
- 3. Institution has not uploaded Details of Mutation Certificate of Land.
- 4. In the LUC, signature designation of the competent authority is in Tamil language. Translated version of the **English** document in version Notarized by the Notary is not uploaded by the institution.
- 5. Building plan for Sy.No. 3/96 is not uploaded by the institution. The photocopy of the building is meant for D.T.Ed., B.Ed. and M.Ed. courses only. Building plan approved by the competent authority for offering B.Sc.B.Ed.

- 6. Non-Encumbrance Certificate is not uploaded by the institution.
- 7. Institution has not uploaded the details of students admitted in the application.
- 8. Authorization letter on the stamp paper is not submitted by the Management.
