Implemented through volunteerism, ULLAS promotes social responsibility and a sense of duty 'Kartavya Bodh'.
- 3. Volunteer students will be incentivized through credits. Two (2) Credits for Community Engagement & Service (ITEP Curricular Components) of which are to be awarded to ITEP students for their active participation in activities related to NSS, ULLAS-New India Literacy Programme (NILP) etc. This will aim to foster youth volunteerism to achieve 100% literacy across the country. The student teachers and faculty from TEIs are expected to register themselves on the ULLAS mobile app and fully dedicate themselves towards the noble cause of 100% literacy which is essential for realising the goal of Viksit Bharat.
- 4. In this regard, it is expected that student - teachers and faculty from TEIs recognised by NCTE would join ULLAS and engage in an orientation cum induction programme for encouraging student to be volunteers in ULLAS. An online induction session will be held on 3rd October 2024 for TEIs organised by NCTE under the aegis of Ministry of Education, Government of India.
