WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely, Sri Raghavendra College of Education, # 29, Chimney Hills, Pipeline Road, Chikabanavara Post, Bangalore, Karnataka run by Sri Raghavendra Educational Institutions Society, Bangalore, Karnataka vide SRC vide order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2005-2006/4936 dt. 24.12.2005 for conducting secondary (B.Ed.) course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2005-2006.

- AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit dated 27.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 16.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students for one basic unit from the academic session 2015-16.
- AND WHEREAS, a corrigendum was issued to the institution vide order no. F.SRO/NCTE/APS02057/B.Ed/KA/2015-16/81238 dt. 03.02.2016 for grants recognition to Sri Raghavendra College of Education, # 29, Chimney Hills, Pipeline Road, Chikabanavara Post, Bangalore, Karnataka for conducting B.Ed. Programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students each (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-2016.
- AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 348th meeting held on 5th 6th December 2017 has considered the matter and decided to issue Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 13.12.2017. The institution has submitted reply on 08.01.2018.
- AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 381st meeting held on 31st Oct & 01st Nov 2019 has considered the matter and decided to issue Final show Cause Notice. Accordingly, a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 13.11.2019. The institution has submitted reply on 05.12.2019
- AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 405th Meeting held on 13th & 14th December, 2021 considered the matter and decided as under: -

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

The institution was issued a Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN). The institution has submitted its reply vide letter dated 05.12.2019. The Committee observed the reply submitted by the institution and found the following deficiencies.

- 1. The institution submitted a copy of letter dt. 28.10.2016 issued by the Registrar, Bangalore University whereby 12 faculty (including Principal) have been approved with the condition to clear Ph.D. / NET/SLET within two years. The conditional appointment is not permissible under NCTE Regulations. Further, the strength of faculty is not enough to run B.Ed. course (2 units) as per Appendix 4 of NCTE Regulations. The institution has also not submitted latest approval of faculty issued by the affiliating University.
- 2. The institution did not submit proof of disbursement of salary to faculty & non-teaching staff through bank account as required under clause 10(2) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.
- 3. The institution did not submit details of administrative and professional staff as required under clause 5.3 of Appendix 4 of NCTE Regulations, 2014.
- 4. The website of the institution is not uploaded with the information required under clauses 7(14)(i), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.
- 5. The institution did not submit Affidavit regarding land & building in original.
- 6. The building plan submitted by the institution is not approved by the competent authority.
- 7. The institution has not submitted a BCC.
- 8. The institution did not submit Encumbrance Certificate issued by the competent authority.
- 9. The institution did not submit details of other programmes being run in the campus.

Hence, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition granted to Sri Raghavendra College of Education, #29, Chimney Hills, Pipeline Road, Chikabanavara Post, Bangalore-560090, Karnataka for conducting B.Ed. programme with effect from the academic session i.e., 2022-2023 onwards under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above."

- 7. NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to Sri Raghavendra College of Education, #29, Chimney Hills, Pipeline Road, Chikabanavara Post, Bangalore-560090, Karnataka run by Sri Raghavendra Educational Institutions Society, Bangalore, Karnataka for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (2 basic units) with effect from the academic session i.e., 2021-2022 onwards.
- **8.** Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or

# other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

9. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website <a href="https://www.ncte-india.org">www.ncte-india.org</a> within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
